N. S. APPLES NET \$7.85 A BARREL

"The biggest price ever obtained for Nova Scotia apples in the London market," said C. R. H. Starr, of Wolfville, who spoke to The Halifax Herald about it yesterday.

There have been higher average prices than are being realized this season, good as it is, but none that equal the figure I have given. The facts are, Mr. Starr went on to say, "that an orchardist at Port Williams shipped to Nothard and Lowe, London, twenty barrels of apples by the Furness liner Gulf of Anoud, which sold as follows: Twelve barrels Cox's orange pippin at 50s, two do. at 30s, and six Kings at 21s.

These varieties are grown in England, but the crop is short this year.—Halifax Herald.
