### Supplies For Doukhobors.

PHILADELPHIA, Pa., Dec. 15.—A committee of Philadelphia friends have begun the shipment of 35,000 pounds of supplies for the Doukhobors or Russian Quakers, in Canada. The consignment includes two cars of cornmeal, four of malted milk and tea, three hundred seed oil, 15 bales of washed wool for clothing, 40 sacks of barley, boxes of malted milk and tea. Three hundred spinning wheels are to be sent later. When the Doukhobors arrived from Russia, Philadelphia Quakers sent them about \$8,000 and a few weeks ago a shipment of 42,000 lbs of supplies and \$2,000 was forwarded to them. They will require much assistance during the winter as their first crop last summer was nearly ruined by frost.

### Those Fast Ships.

The newspapers are calling upon the Government to employ the Cutarlers as well as the White Star steamers as transports, seeing the urgent necessity for getting more men to the Cape as speedily as possible. Forty thousand men could be still sent from England without calling upon the militia for foreign service. The militia effective is 100,000 men, and from that body 20,000 carefully selected men could easily be spared for South Africa. Moreover, the colonies are again offering assistance. The greatest need, therefore, is speedy transports.  
Sir Charles Warren, who arrived at Cape Town yesterday, will probably join Lord Methuen and take command of the combined forces.
