FALL STYLES IN MILLINERY

Just at this season, when the thoughts of the world feminine, are centred on Millinery in general, and what will suit each individual style in particular, it may not be amiss to give a delineation of the prevailing modes for the season. The very many ladies who attended the Millinery Opening have been privileged to view the very latest models from the world of Fashion, all the trimmed models being the work of Miss Turillou, chief milliner and her capable assistants. That there is a decided change in shapes is, at a glance apparent, the many-fluted brooping brims of the previous season having given place to straight brims, very narrow in front, gradually widening out to be extremely long and drooping in back. Again there are bell-shaped hats which promise to be favorites. These are worn off the face, giving an entirely new and stylish effect. The extreme high crowns come mostly in made dress hats, smoothly covered in velvet, silk or satin, the felt shaves almost invariably having the lower crowns. "Flops" and "Hoods" in fine soft finished felt are extremely good, and with these the milliner has full scope, as she can practically control the shape, manipulating it to suit each individual wear. The prevailing fashionable outline. A shape that promises to take well, has a very short front brim, very broad at the sides, and narrower again at the back. These are shown both in felt and silk-covered and are generally becoming. The Henry VIII is another new type. This shape has a high beef-steak crown with a narrow stiff mushroom brim. The shapes generally are most picturesque but are a totally different type from the Louis styles we have so long been accustomed to. As to trimmings—feathers of all kinds demand first place, the long handsome sweeping Ostrich plumes, as well as the tall effects, taking the lead. Next to

Ostrich is the prime effect in fancy feathers, such as Marabout &c, which are less expensive. Also the C. q. e plumes, wide soft wing effects, long pointed wings and fancy birds' heads, ending in soft waving plumes. Feathers to be in every imaginable shading and combination of shades. Ribbons also are good style, wide lappets being most useful with an increasing demand for the satin necker. Velvet is not important, not only for the all-velvet hat, but for trimming purposes as well. Hats plainly covered with Molre silk are fashionable, while satin covered are ultra. Ornaments are more in vogue than for many seasons past, and are of many shapes and materials, mostly large and very handsome. The large bill pins which have been popular the past season, are more beautiful and more popular than ever. Persian lanterns are a novelty, also much in vogue. Flowers—especially in the large blooms are decidedly good, as is also a Fox glove, which comes in velvet lean fully lined and shaded. In colors the "velvet" or rich h-lot brown and purple shades are the newest. Brown is decidedly strong, and green in the emerald and emerald shades especially fashionable. Burgundy red and garnet as well as Atlantic and peacock blue are all popular.
