GERMANY'S RE-INFORCEMENTS

LONDON, Aug. 10.—Central News despatches from Brussels say that Belgian troops have captured a hundred thousand rifles of latest pattern. The exchange Telegraph Company's correspondent at Brussels says in the event of the check of Germans being continued it is apparent that the second stage of the campaign must commence in a few days. Meanwhile the Germans are getting all possible strength together.

er. The situation, viewed from all points, is highly favorable to the allies.

PARIS, Aug. 10.—Official statements of the fighting around Liege have been made here. One account says Germans lost 20,000 dead, 24 guns captured and one General made prisoner. The German force numbered 120,000 and the Belgians 40,000. The German attack lacked cohesion, on the contrary the Belgians used their reserve with consummate skill. The German artillery in general was badly supported by dense

attacking columns, their guns were badly served and inaccurate. The Belgians' forts were reported to have been accurate and well played, as proof of which two heavy German guns were destroyed. German air craft to Belgium carried Belgian flags.

BRUSSELS, via London, Aug. 10.—The following statement was issued by the General Staff: The position of the German troops has hardly changed since Saturday. The advance guards are retreating under irresistible pressure from the Belgian forces and the French troops which

are driving the Germans back through Alace. Liege still holds out with its forts intact.

MILITIA CONTROLS WIRELESS

TORONTO, Aug. 7.—Militia Controls Wireless on orders from the Militia Department, the police today took over all the amateur wireless outfits in the city. Government controlled apparatus will be allowed to operate. In the meanwhile all canals and important public works in the Province are being guarded.
