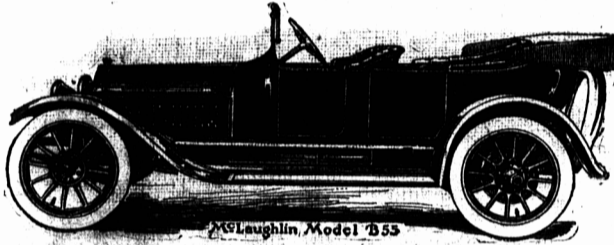

### MR. BALFOUR ON BELIEF

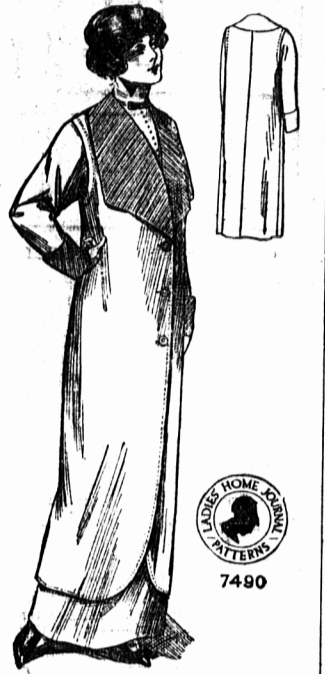
Amusing Illustrations From Games of Chance

Mr. A. J. Balfour, in his Gifford lecture at Glasgow University caused some amusement by his incidental references, by way of illustration, to games of chance, such as pitch and toss, and to the chances of the gaming tables of Monte Carlo, together with the chances of a railway accident. He was referring to the method of qualifying propositions as possible, as actual, and as necessary. There were, he said, calculations of chance not in the least based on experience. They were based on a priori calculation. Taking the simple case of tossing a penny, there was no more reason why the penny should fall heads than tails, and they said the chances were even. It was because chances of that sort were to be depended on that the inhabitants of Monte Carlo paid no rates (laughter), and that visitors who went there nearly always left its sunny shores much poorer. Mr. Balfour added that he was more concerned with the qualification of the inevitable and the probable. His lecture was largely devoted to the distinction between different kinds of probability. There were probable beliefs, dealt with by the calculus of probability, amenable to what were called the laws of chance. There were other beliefs, not amenable to the law of chance, not explicable by the calculus of probabilities, but which were nevertheless part of the necessary foundation upon which the superstructure of their scientific knowledge, and indeed all their knowledge, was based. He asked them to keep two things in mind. One was that probabilities and tendencies fell together, outside what logicians termed the theory of probability, and the other was that these tendencies, inclinations, and probabilities were to be classed with the inevitable beliefs.

The top coat is an indispensable garment to any wardrobe. For the shorter designs, the light-weight wools and the novelty cotton materials are favored, but for a full-length design, such as is shown in No. 7490, a light-weight serge or ratine would be preferable, as they have a slightly more dressy appearance and the coat may then be used for many purposes other than sport. If ratine or serge were used with this design, the broad collar, revers and cuffs would be effective made of cotton velvet, bengaline or moire in a somewhat brighter shade than the body of the coat. This coat has one of the new wide armholes with the sleeve set in at a normal shoulder line. The length of the coat is 48 inches. For size 36, 4 1/4 yards of 42-inch material will be required with five-eighths of a yard of contrasting material for collar and cuffs. The pattern is cut in six sizes, 32 to 42. ### BIBLICAL TRAINING

Give Children a Good Grounding in Principles of Morality

"My chief desire is to see the children attending public schools receive a better education in Biblical subjects, and a good grounding in the principles of morality," said Dr. Sneath, superintendent of education for Ontario, who declared himself very emphatically in favor of a public school education which would not be merely intellectual. He deplored the present serious lack of religious and moral training in primary schools, and viewed it in the light of a danger to a democratic community. Briefly, Dr. Sneath's scheme provides for instruction in Bible knowledge and systematic training in morality. Such instruction may include denominational doctrines. The reading of the Bible at the opening of school is also prescribed, but it is left optional with the boards to require such reading at the close, the repeating of the Ten Commandments, and the memorization of passages from the Bible. At present, in the course of study, provision is made for incidental instruction in manners and morals.
