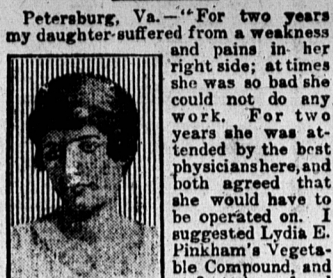
Notices of Canadian Northwest Land Regulations
