Five of these voted for the amendment while a sixth refrained from voting. The Government majority against the amendment was 38. The alleged revolt seems not to be at all serious in view of this division.

A New York Socialist organ has been taking what is called a "straw vote" for Presidential candidates. The published result shows, 41,384 for Roosevelt, 428 for Taft, 65,928 for Debs, 54,720 for McNamara and 48,225 for Gompers. This can hardly be accepted as a test of national sentiment.

The Glasgow grave diggers, who are not union men, have gone on strike for shorter hours and better wages. Their chief complaint, however, is against Sunday funerals, which compel them to work seven days in the week. They are quite justifiable in striking against Sunday funerals.
