PILGRIM FRUIT CAKE

A light fruit cake, neither too expensive nor too rich, with an unusual elusive flavor, is always a joy during the holiday season.

Cream—one-half a cup of butter, add gradually, while still beating.

one cup of sugar and two well-beaten eggs Mix and sift one cup and one-half of flour, two tablespoonfuls of baking powder, and one-half a teaspoonful of salt. Add the dry ingredients to the butter mixture, alternating with the raisins, chopped; one-half a cup of citron, thinly sliced and cut in

carefully and if the batter seems stiff add one more tablespoonful of milk. Add the grated rind of one lemon and two spoonfuls of rose extract. Then fold in the following fruits: one cup of seedless raisins, chopped; one-half a cup of citron, thinly sliced and cut in

pieces; one-half a cup of almonds, blanched and shredded; and one-fourth a cup of candied orange peel. Bake as a loaf in a well-buttered tin about 8 inches by 4 inches by 3 inches, at 325 deg. F. for 55-60 minutes.
