## THE NEED OF A LIBRARY.

The want of a Public Library is to-day as it has long been, one of the great intellectual needs of Charlottetown. Until we become possessed of it we shall remain, in one most important regard, behind every other City of Canada, and behind many of the smaller towns and villages. The past century has been pre-eminently an age of books; the century upon which we are entering will be more emphatically so. A few of our wealthier citizens can and do supply themselves with the best written works of ages past, and the works of eminent writers of the day. But this privilege is denied to the many and a Public Library alone can supply it. We have spent public money with a liberal hand for the education of our youth, but we have apparently forgotten that the teaching of the schools is but preparatory to that education which ought to go on through life and is to be acquired from books. We need a Public Library to supply to adult citizens this great means of intellectual advancement and expansion; we need it to give our citizens the better privileges enjoyed in other cities; we need it to take away our reproach as a city without books. Space will not permit that we shall enlarge upon this fruitful and urgent topic, but most earnestly do we urge both women and men to attend the meeting, called by His Worship the Mayor, to be held to-night in promotion of the Library movement.
