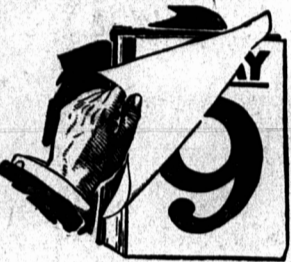

ST. LAWRENCE NOW ATTRACTING ATTENTION.

The early opening of navigation on the St. Lawrence this year is attracting a great deal of interesting comment on the possibilities of extending the season of navigation.

The big White Star Liner "Tonic" sailed April 19th for Quebec and Montreal, opening the season, and had a record list of passengers. On the return trip she will sail Tuesday, May 6th, instead of Saturday, as formerly, the Canadian Government having designated the White Star Dominion Line to carry the Tuesday mails until July next, when they will resume Saturday sailings with the mail contract.

This company is planning to give persons of small means an opportunity to go abroad for four weeks this summer, visiting England and the Continent, at a total expense of \$167.60, including cabin accommodation on the steamer and all expenses ashore. A considerable number have already signified their intention of making the trip.
