The market yesterday was poorly attended owing to the condition of the roads and weather. The only change in the market prices was that of eggs, which sold from twenty-four cents to twenty-six cents.

Roy C. Lea has sold his residence No. 1 Larch Street, near Coburg Road, to Myron Henderson. The sale was put through by William Tapp, auctioneer and real estate agent—Halifax Herald. Mr. Lea is a son of Jabez Lea, Tryon, P.E.I., and leaves in the near future for Calgary, where he will reside.

Last evening in Zion Church schoolroom a large audience assembled to hear Rev. R. G. Strathie deliver his lecture entitled "Climbing Up the Ladder." Rev. Mr. Strathie's lecture was both interesting and instructive and was followed with keenest appreciation by the large assembly. At the close of the lecture the lecturer was tendered a hearty vote of thanks by His Honor Lieutenant Governor Rogers who presided. This was moved by F. J. Nash and seconded by J. A. Lawson.

The annual meeting of the Charlottetown Mutual Fire Insurance Company was held in the Board of Trade Rooms on Monday evening. There were present a large number of shareholders and the directors. The meeting was presided over by Hon. G. E. Hughes, city, president of the association. The secretary's report brought down showed that the company had had a very successful year. After paying the fire losses of the year and the running expenses the company had added over \$1200 to capital account. The company now has a substantial reserve fund on hand. The election of a Board of Directors resulted in the following being chosen—Hon. G. E. Hughes, President; S. A. McDonald, A. C. Duchemin, F. H. Beer, J. A. Farquharson, Robert Pennell, and R. M. Johnson. Benj. Balderson was reappointed secretary.

Some time ago the C. S. G. Association planned to distribute some good seed oats in the Province of Quebec. An attempt was made to produce it in Ont., but the samples submitted did not prove satisfactory. The Provincial Department of Agriculture in this city was then asked if P. E. Island could supply the seed and in a short time a carload was secured in the vicinity of Summerside and shipped to Quebec. The Guardian is glad to say that this seed was very well received. The representative of the Seed Branch writes as follows: "The P. E. Island seed oats arrived in good shape, 200 bags of them were sold in 5 bag lots and brought from 75c. to \$1.00 per bushel. The balance was stored at the Experimental Farm near Quebec to be distributed in the spring. The Seed Commission, G. H. Clark and the Minister of Agriculture, Hon. Sydney Fisher, were both present and were much pleased with the quality of the seed. The oats were a credit to P. E. Island and I wish to thank you for your assistance in getting it together in good time." P. E. Island can produce the very highest quality of seed oats, but the market for it is hurt every year by dishonest men shipping inferior oats for seed. It remains with the farmers of P. E. Island to determine the prices they shall get for their seed. There is plenty of market for the best quality that can be grown.

DUKE OF CONNAUGHT TO SUCCEED EARL GREY

(Continued from page 1.) become governor-general of Canada in succession to Lord Grey. Official notification to that effect has been received by the government. The appointment of his royal highness is for two years, but it may at the end of that time be further extended. The Duke and Duchess with their suite will take up their residence at Rideau Hall in September, meanwhile some improvements are contemplated for that somewhat unimpressive building to make it more in keeping with a royal residence.

It has been found that, owing to the need of his highness' presence in England as next in rank to the king in respect of official state functions, pending the minority of the Prince of Wales, he could hardly be spared to Canada at present. Any difficulties in this respect have, however, not been deemed unsurmountable, and the original desire of King Edward, that the importance and status of Canada as the first daughter nation of the empire should be suitably recognized by the appointment of a foremost member of the royal family

to represent the crown here, will be carried out. Both because of his high position and because of his own personality and unblemished record as soldier and administrator, the duke's appointment is cordially welcomed by the people of Canada as a whole. Official intimation to this effect has been sent to King George.

It is understood that there is no intention of establishing a royal court in Canada. His highness will, like his predecessors, be a democratic governor, and save for the fact of his royal lineage and the added éclat and dignity thus given to the post of governor-general, there will be no change in the present happy relationships of government and people with the representative of the crown at the Canadian capital.

The duke's connection with Canada is a long and pleasant one. Forty years ago, when a youth of twenty,

the duke came to Canada and served as a soldier through the Fenian raid. Since then the duke has several times returned to Canada, each time enhancing not only his own but his family's popularity. It will also be remembered that his son, Prince Arthur, won golden opinions in Canada when he toured the dominion four years ago.
