MINUTES OF THE PRESBYTERY OF P. E. ISLAND

Pulpit Supplies Arranged—Augmentation Allocations made—Increase of Salary to Missionary—And Various Other Matters Attended to.

At Mount Stewart, and within the Presbyterian Church there, on Tuesday Nov. 12th 1907, and at one o'clock p.m., the Presbytery of Prince Edward Island met pursuant to adjournment and was constituted by the moderator Mr. W. H. Spencer, with whom were present Messrs A. B. McLeod, John Hawley, G. C. Robertson, Geo. E. Ross, A. Craise, Ministers, T. C. James and Isaac Jay, elders, Mr. Geo. E. Ross conducted public worship in presence of a large assembly of the congregation, and preached an inspiring sermon from the words And they stood every man in his place. Judges 7:21.

The moderator stated the purpose of the meeting, and a conference was held with the people in regard to pulpit supply for the winter months. The following commissioners were present from Marshfield: John T. Ferguson, W. J. Gibson, R. Munn and P. M. Robertson.

Mr. G. C. Robertson tendered his resignation of the moderatorship of the session of Mount Stewart and West St. Peter's and Mr. John Hawley was appointed in his place. Arrangements were then made, satisfactory to all concerned, for services in both churches.

It was moved, seconded and carried that the thanks of the Presbytery be tendered to the commissioners from Marshfield for their attendance.

On motion the following augmentation allocations were made: Marshfield and West River \$16 each, Richmond Bay East, Tignish, Hampton, Bloomfield, Mount

Stewart, Dundas, Murray Harbor North, Murray Harbor South, Wood Islands, Caledonia \$32 each, East St. Peter's Covehead, Georgetown, Orwell, Richmond Bay West, \$35 each, Cardigan, Alberton \$42 each, Cavendish, Brookfield, Strathalbyn, Montague, Souris, \$45 each, Clifton, Bekeque, Valleyfield \$50 each, Belfast \$66, Kensington, Malpeque \$75 each, Summerside \$80, St. James Charlottetown Zion, Charlottetown, \$88 each.

For the purpose of carrying out the Presbytery's endeavor to raise the salary of Rev. A. D. McKenzie missionary to Demerara, and in connection therewith introducing the system of weekly offerings it was decided on motion that the Presbytery be divided into the following districts the pastor to be a committee for each the pastor of the first named congregation to be the convener:

1. Alberton, Rev. G. Mullar, Malpeque and Bloomfield.
2. Summerside, Rev. R. G. Strathie, Bekeque, Kensington, Malpeque, Richmond East, and Richmond Bay West.
3. Clifton, Rev. John Murray, Cavendish, Strathalbyn, Brookfield and Hampton.
4. Zion, Ch' Town, Rev. Geo. E. Ross, St. James, Ch' Town, Marshfield, Covehead, Mount Stewart and West River.
5. Belfast, Rev. S. D. McPhee, Caledonia, Wood Islands, Orwell, Murray Harbor and Murray Harbor South.
6. East St. Peter's, Rev. J. W. McKenzie, Dundas, Georgetown, Cardigan, Montague and Souris.

Presbytery then adjourned to meet at the call of the moderator and clerk of which public intimation was made, and this declaration was closed with the benediction.
