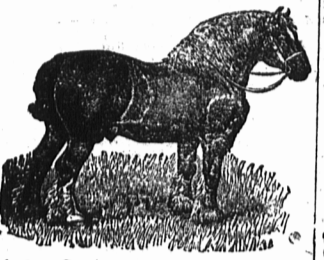

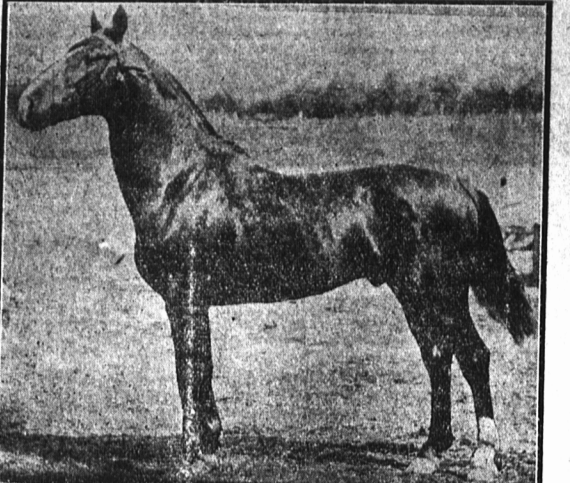


The standard bred registered stallion Pattern Maker 3981, sired by Parkside 229, race record 2:27 1/2 at five years.

JUDGING A HORSE'S AGE BY

The following illustrations are copied from the Farmer's Advocate. It is reproduced for the benefit of island farmers and horsemen.

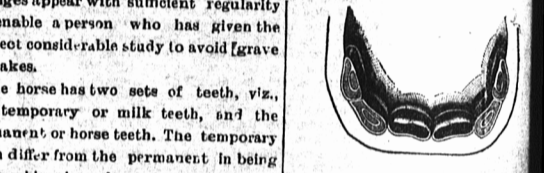


Fig. 1.-Lower jaw at 2 to 3 years.

At six years the marks should be out of the central lower incisors bearing surface of the teeth almost in the lateral; and at eight years the corners of all the lower incisors should be level, and usually, the upper corner incisors, forming a hook.

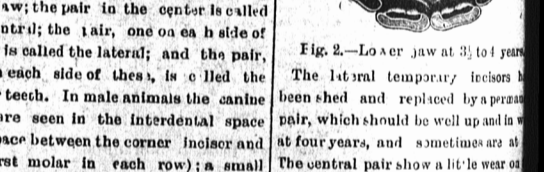


Fig. 2.-Lower jaw at 3 to 4 years.

The lateral temporary incisors have been shed and replaced by a permanent pair, which should be well up and in the central pair show a little wear on outer edge.

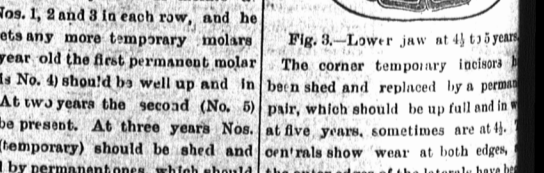


Fig. 3.-Lower jaw at 4 to 5 years.

The corner temporary incisors have been shed and replaced by a permanent pair, which should be well up and in the central pair show a little wear on outer edge.



Fig. 4.-Lower jaw at 5 to 6 years.

The marks have disappeared from the central incisors, the lateral incisors are showing wear, and the inner edges of the corners even with the outer.

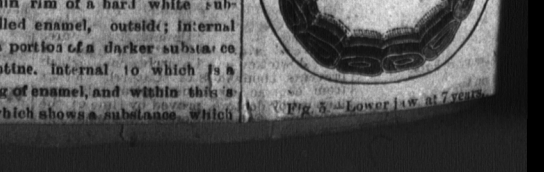
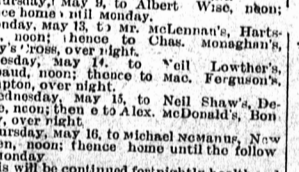


Fig. 5.-Lower jaw at 6 to 7 years.

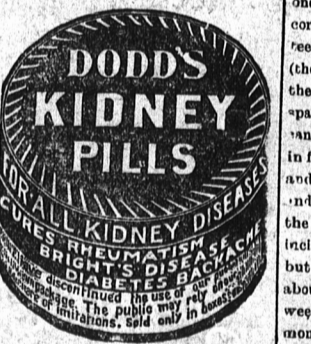

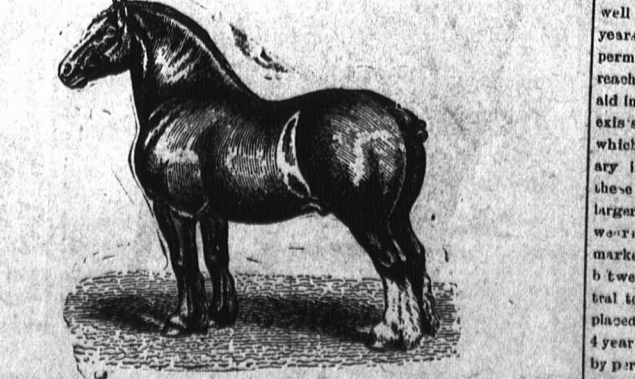

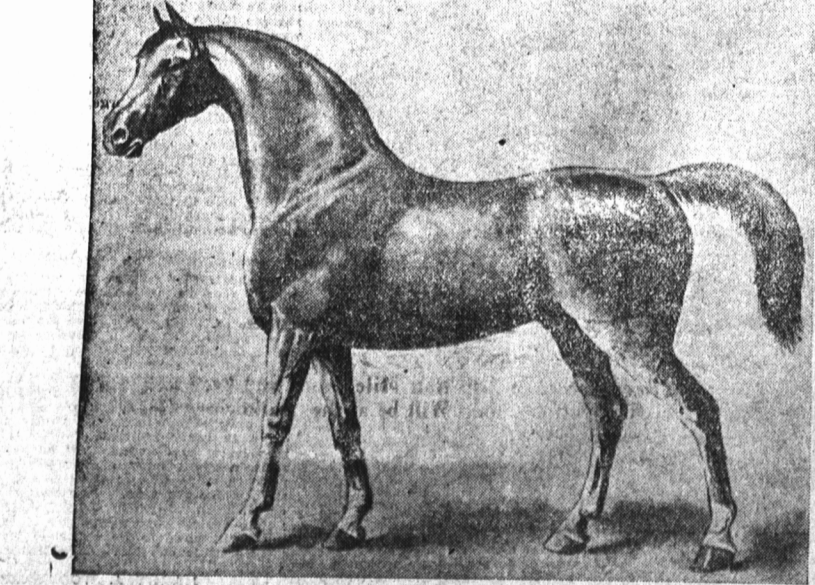
