RHUBARB PIE WITH HOT LEMON SAUCE

1 recipe plain pastry
1 cup sugar
2 tablesp-ns flour
1-8 teaspoon salt
2 eggs, well beaten
3 cups rhubarb, cut in 1-2-inch pieces


Line 9-inch pie plate with pastry. Combine remaining ingredients and pour into pastry shell. Cover with upper crust and bake in a hot oven (425 degrees F.) for 10 minutes and then reduce heat to moderate (325 degrees F.) and bake 25 to 30 minutes longer. Serve with hot lemon sauce. Approximate yield: 1 nine-inch pie.

LEMON SAUCE

2 tablespoons butter
1-2 cup sugar
2 tablespoons flour
1-8 teaspoon salt
1 tablespoon lemon juice
Grated rind of 1 lemon
1-2 cups boiling water
1 egg, beaten

Cream butter and sugar together; add flour, salt, lemon juice and rind. Add boiling water gradually, stirring until mixture thickens. Add cooked egg, and cook 2 minutes longer; but do not allow to boil.

No one hands her any bouquets because she wears petticoats. RHUBARB BALLS

1 cup rice
2 cups stewed rhubarb
Powdered sugar

Cook rice in boiling salted water until tender. Drain and wash away starch. Divide in 8 parts and spread each on a piece of cheesecloth approximately 9 by 9 inches. The rice should be about 1-4 inch thick and spread in a circle. Fill the middle with pieces of stewed rhubarb sweetened to taste, then draw the cheesecloth up so that the rice forms a ball and covers the rhubarb; tie securely with string, drop into boiling water and cook for 1 hour. Turn out and dust with powdered sugar. Serve with cream or any desired sauce. Approximate yield: 8 portions.

RHUBARB WITH ALMONDS

2 pounds rhubarb
Juice and grated rind of 1 lemon
Sugar

1 tablespoon gelatin
2 tablespoons cold water
2 cup boiling water
Blanched almonds

Wash and cut rhubarb, leaving skin on; simmer with very little water until tender. Force through strainer, add lemon juice and rind and sweeten to taste. Soften gelatin in cold water for 5 minutes. Add boiling water and rhubarb mixture and stir until gelatin is dissolved. Pour into mold and chill until firm. Unmold and stick blanched almonds, which have been cut into strips or halved, into surface in any desired design. Approximate yield: 6 to 8 portions.

RHUBARB PUNCH

3 lbs. rhubarb
6 qts. boiling water
2 lbs. (4 1-2 c.) granulated sugar
9 lemons
2 qts. ginger ale

Cut rhubarb in 1-2-inch slices; add water, and cook 10 minutes. Strain; add sugar and cool. Add juice of lemons and oranges. Chill. Just before serving, add some ice and ginger ale. Serves 50.

MAY

This is the month for mothers, tranquility, and blanching. It is for them that Nature decks with colors of buds and fragrant flowers each day.

YELLOW AND RED

Its smart to play in yellow and red—for instance, a red hat with a yellow wheel.

DEBUNKED

Sap does not rise in spring, contrary to common belief. There is an increased circulation of tree liquids; with more being found in the outside cell zones than in winter, but the seasonal rise and fall is unfounded.

SHABBY FLOOR IS DETRIMENT

Shabby floors often prevent that spic-and-span appearance which most housewives desire in their homes. If the condition of the floor prevents satisfactory refinishing, a new floor is in order. New hardwood floors may be laid over the existing floor. Before the new flooring is laid it is necessary to make sure that the old floor is level and free from bumps and that all loose boards are securely nailed down. Boards that cannot be planed or nailed down level should be replaced, and all rough edges should be sandedpapered. The molding strip at the bottom of the baseboard should be removed

and a good quality of building paper laid over the old floor. New flooring is applied at right angles to the old floor. A thin flooring felt is satisfactory but not one that is less than three-eighths inch thick. If new flooring has not been laid in all rooms, sloping saddles or thresholds will have to be placed at doorways to overcome the difference in floor levels and the doors refitted by cutting off at the bottom. After finishing, baseboard molding strips should be replaced.

HOW TO HANG OUT THE WASHING

Someone once said there was a wrong and a right way to do everything, so here's the right way to dry your laundry. All large, white things, such as sheets and tablecloths, should be thrown one-third over the line and fastened very securely with pegs. Colored things should be turned wrong side out and dried in the shade suspended on the straight. Always peg so that any stripes run vertically to the ground and never let them go horizontally or they may run into the next color. Colored bath towels should be hung at intervals to get rid of the weight of water. Another way to dry sweaters is to pull them into shape and then lay them on a towel to dry. Silks and rayons should be hung with care, and not pegged, as pegs mark them. Dry in the shade, or by an electric fan.

HOME HINTS

If a cookie cutter is dipped into flour before each cutting it will not stick to the dough.

Hot vinegar will soften paint brushes that have been hardened. To complete the cleaning job, wash brushes in warm suds.

A roast that gives promise of being tough may be made tender by rubbing a little vinegar or lemon juice into it before putting it into the oven.

Woolen blankets should never be put through the wringer machine. Hang them on the line dripping wet. When dry, beat until they are soft and fluffy.

Prunes lend themselves to almost any form of bread pudding. For this purpose it is well to soak them until the stones can be taken out easily, and then chop them.

New pillow ticking should be ironed with a hot iron which has been rubbed over beeswax. The wax acts as a coating which prevents feathers and down working through the ticking.

When washing a chenille bedspread, fold it in half with the chenille inside and hang with corners over the line. And the nap will need no stuffing.

ESSENTIALS OF SKIN-CARE

What are the basic essentials of skin-care? First, come the fundamentals—of regular daily habits: once a week or when the spirit moves you is no good. First of these habits comes thorough and constant cleansing. Second comes "nourishing" or "feeding" the skin, thickly comes protecting it.

Cleansing. Three times a day, please. Early morning, midday and night. Choose your cleansing-preparations according to your type of skin. Very greasy to greasy complexions generally react best to soap and water and a tonic cleansing-milk. Dry to very dry to more nourishing type of cleansing-milk. Those with normal skins can take their choice of anything they like, provided they use their intelligence; that is to say that every-one's skin varies slightly according to the season, state of health, living-conditions, etc. The intelligent woman keeps a watchful eye on her complexion. If it looks greasier than usual, she cleans it with soap or tonic-milk. If it gets too dry, she changes to cream. Hard-and-fast rules and the idea that because you have got used to a preparation it must be right for you, are a mistake where skin-cleansing is concerned.

NOURISHING

Never-strain, bad weather, overheated rooms all tend to "take the life" out of your skin. What the rigors of modern life take out you must put back. Deeply-penetrating oils, softening agents, tissue-building fats, all blended together in one delicately-perfumed cream, can be obtained, these days, for less than the price of a pair of silk stockings. And if it's a case of choosing between your face and your feet, go bare-legged, every time.

PROTECTING

The skin if exposed to extremes of heat and cold, wind, rain and so forth, eventually puts up its own form of resistance and becomes tanned and hard like leather. Effective, but not becoming. First line of defence against leatheriness, deeply-enriched lines, wrinkles and so forth is, obviously, your nightly allowance of nourishing-cream. But your second—and also very important—line of defence is what you put on your face during the daytime. Your powder-foundation is not only intended to make your powder stay put. It is also meant to carry on with the good job of softening and protecting your complexion. And your powder itself also acts as a screen and a protection, and is not just something to stop your face from shining.
