A Discussion of the Saloon as it is — Proposed Clause for Saloon Keeper's Will.

Extract from a sermon preached at Father Mathew Memorial Services Paulist Fathers Church New York, Sunday evening October 12, 1922 by Rev. Patrick G. Murphy, C. S. P.

A BUSINESS ARGUMENT

The strongest argument is a business argument. The greatest promoters of drunkenness to-day are those who have money invested in the business, and who want to make it pay.

THE SALOON AS IT IS

I remember hearing a priest in a certain town, on one occasion, make this remark. He said: "If I had a deer, personal enmity against some one in this town tomorrow, and if I wanted a mean, low time committed against that person; if I wanted to have a wrong done to that man's family; if I wanted a theft or a robbery committed against him, or a murder; if I wanted to see his child seduced or outraged, I would write to a saloon-keeper to do the crime. And he would do it. And if I wanted it well done, I would write to a Catholic saloon-keeper to do it." That statement is made in regard to a certain

town, I know what I am talking about when I say it. And if some of the victims of crimes that were committed in that town could come back from the dead to-night, and if some of the former saloon-keepers of that town could come back from hell tonight, they would tell you that I am right, and they would tell you to keep both eyes open all the time on those who are engaged in the liquor business. It is a bad business, and it takes a bad man to run it as it should be run. Where do you find the criminals of a city? Where do you find the outcasts? Where do you find the gambling places? Where do you find the disreputable resorts? Do you find them in the grocery? Do you find them in the dry-goods store? Do you find them where any lawful and respectable business is carried on? You find them with their own hands in the saloon. When the little ones are crying at home for bread and the unfortunate father is dissipating, where do you find the man who is mean enough to take that poor unfortunate's money, and to look for it; and to be angry if he does not get it? You find him in the saloon. Where do you find those who will permit a Catholic mother to forget the fact that she is the mother? You will find them in the saloon. Where will you find these who may pretend to be your friends, but who would laugh to-morrow if they saw your sister or your child going headlong down to ruin? You will find them in the saloon. Where will you find the man who will grind their teeth at me because I am telling you the truth? You will find them in the saloon. Do you realize that the curse of Jesus Christ is on the saloon? Now, here is the strongest argument in favor of the liquor business. They want your money. It may be necessary for you to lay down every dollar you have; it may be necessary for you to sell the roof-tree from over the heads of your children to get the money. But they want it. It may be necessary for you to scatter your little family to the four winds of heaven to get the money for them. But they want it. It may be necessary for you to wrong the firm that employs you. But the saloon-keepers want your money. It may be necessary for you to sacrifice your health for their sake. But they will accept the sacrifice. It may be necessary to sell your child to a life of sin for their money. But they want it. The money may be the price of blood. They want it. It may be worse than the thirty pieces of silver that Judas Iscariot got for Jesus Christ. But they want it. It does not make any difference whose blood is on the money that you are going to give them. They want it. That money that you give them may be the price of your own immortal soul, and you may be sending it down to hell for ever. But they want it. Yes they may be generous enough to throw a little of it upon the floor of this temple of God. But the church should hesitate to take it, for it is the price of blood. The day that Judas suicided, they took the money that he sold the Master for, and they used it to purchase a burying-place for strangers. There is a little hint for those who are making in the liquor-traffic. Put a clause in your will: "This money is the price of blood, I want you to build a monument over my grave with it. I do not want you to have any Masses for me. The God of Heaven has heard the cries of the little ones and the cries of their mothers against me. The money that raised this monument over my dead body brought my own soul down to hell."

That may be sufficient about those who are in the saloon business. I always like to pay my respects to them. It makes us understand one another. It gives me the happiness of knowing that I have a few more personal enemies of the right kind. They cannot hate me, any more than I hate their business.
