THE PICTOU ADVOCATE SAYS—The Russian Government are feeling the need of experienced ice captains to command the ice breakers they have bought from Canada and Newfoundland and have been negotiating with Captain John Read, who took the Minto over to Russia. They want Captain Read to be admiral of the ice breaking fleet and to take over to Russia with him a number of ice captains. We hear that First Officer Sencaubaugh, of the Stanley, Second Officer Paquet, of the Prince Edward Island and Pilot McGregor Fraser are willing to go to Russia with Capt. Read. The Russians now have two ice breakers bought from Canada, and four secured in Newfoundland and have recently purchased an ice breaker just completed for the Canadian Government for work in the St. Lawrence.

DEATH OF ISLANDER—Thomas J. Ryan, a farm laborer from Prince Edward Island, who became unconscious after a fight, died last week at Fort Fairfield, Me. The police allege that Ryan was hit by Victor Violette and fell, striking his head on a concrete walk. Ryan, who had been drinking, and the authorities are as yet, unable to determine the cause of death. Violette expressed willingness to give himself up.
