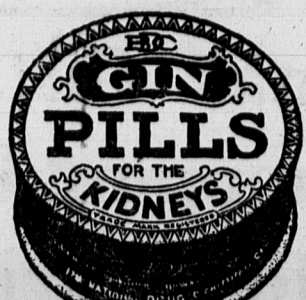

(Canadian Press Despatch) PETROGRAD, Dec. 8.—Not a single shot was fired on the Russian front from the Black Sea to the Baltic on Friday, the armistice having begun officially at noon.

**DARING EXPLOIT OF ITALIAN AIRMAN**

(Canadian Press Despatch) ITALIAN HEADQUARTERS IN NORTHERN ITALY 8.—(By the Associated Press.)—Lieutenant Ancellotto, of the Italian Aviation Corps has executed one of the most daring exploits of the war, telescoping an Austrian Balloon which was observing Venice from the Piave line. He passed through the gas bag at terrific speed setting it ablaze and returned uninjured. He won a Government bonus of 6,000 lire for this exploit.

**REVOLUTION IN PORTUGAL**

(Canadian Press Despatch) PORTO, Dec. 10.—Telegraphic information says that the revolution in Portugal was successful and the Government has resigned. Dr. John Costa, former Premier and Minister of Finance has formed a provisional Government, including ex-Dr. Sidonil Paes, former Portuguese Minister to Germany.

**Support Union Government**

The representative men of the two great political parties came together in Union Government to make Canada's effort in the war most effective in the support of our men at the front with additional forces, and to direct and control the industrial and economic life of Canada to the one end of winning the war. **Wives, Mothers, Daughters and Sisters—You Have a Vote**

Every woman may vote who is a British subject, 21 years of age, resident in Canada one year, and in the constituency 30 days, who is the mother, wife, widow, daughter, sister or half-sister of any person, male or female, living or dead, who is serving, or has served without Canada in any of the Military forces, or within or without Canada in any of the Naval forces of Canada or of Great Britain in the present war, or who has been honorably discharged from such services, and the date of whose enlistment was prior to Sept. 20, 1917.
