His many friends will regret to learn that Mr. Charles Miller, of Glenfanning is very sick for some time, with La Grippe.

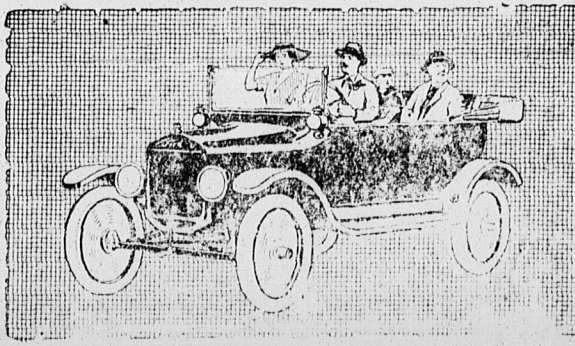

Mrs. A. J. Cole, R. N., who has been visiting her sister, Miss H. J. McIntyre, Grand River, has returned to New York city.

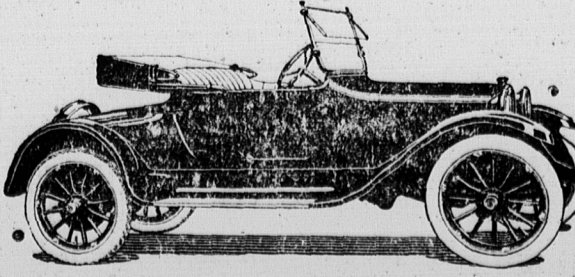
