Contract Bridge

A COMMON ERROR
 South in today's deal was guilty of a very common bidding error, one which cost his side a vulnerable game.
 North, dealer.
 North-South vulnerable.
 ♠ AK532

West made his normal opening of the heart ten — the top of his incomplete interior sequence — and after that South did not have the ghost of a chance for nine tricks. When he attempted to set up his own diamonds, he could not keep the opponents from winning four heart tricks and either a spade or a club, depending on South's choice.
 As may be seen, this outcome was in sorry contrast with the number of tricks that North could have made so easily at a spade contract, where he would lose only one trump and one club. Now let's examine the bidding to discover whether the partners were merely unfortunate in their choice of contracts, or whether they were at fault in this respect.
 Certainly, North's opening spade bid was correct — he was not strong enough for a two-spade opening. South's choice of responses, however, cannot be disposed of so casually. It is true that South lacked the high-card values for a two-diamond response, but his obvious feeling that the only alternative was one no-trump was not valid. In a situation of this sort, when the responder has three of partner's suit, a singleton, and about 1-2 honor-tricks, his wisest course by far is to give a single raise in his partner's suit!
 The objection will be raised that South lacked "adequate trump support," but when it is a case of compromising slightly in this respect or bidding a no-trump on unbalanced distribution, the direct single raise is almost sure to be the lesser evil. If South had bid two spades instead of one no-trump, North of course, would have jumped to four spades.
