PROHIBITION.

The counties of this Province have now long been under the provisions of the Canada Temperance Act, and the electors by repeated votes have so strongly affirmed their determination in its favor that the opponents of the Act have despaired of ever bringing about its repeal. Charlottetown was doubtful ground so far as the C. T. Act was concerned, the local majority being sometimes in favor of and sometimes against it. But now that the provincial Legislature has given us a law equalising the sale of liquors in the city and the principle upon which the law is based having been declared constitutional by the Privy Council we have the liquor traffic placed under ban in the entire Province. And we are satisfied that the law will never be repealed. No Legislature can be found in Prince Edward Island now or hereafter which will repeal the law and open any part of the Province to the legal sale of liquors. The determination of the large majority of the electors of the Island is to keep the liquor trade under perpetual prohibition. It only remains to enforce the laws we have as can best be done until they are made more stringent and effective. The great danger is from partial or intermittent enforcement. The penalties must be so enforced that no man can make a profit in the illegal trade. No man, however bad he may be will long continue to sell whiskey when the fines enforced are greater than the profits. A determined vigilant enforcement of the law would speedily drive the last rum-seller out of business. It is idle as well as untrue to say that liquor laws cannot be enforced. They can be enforced. Within British territory it ought to be solemnly and solidly affirmed at all times that all laws can be carried out. The prohibition laws form no exception to the rule.

There is unfortunately a growing prospect of war between Chili and Argentina growing out of a territorial dispute. The trouble was sometime since referred to the arbitration of Great Britain, but both republics under cover of pacific professions are actively preparing for war, mobilising troops and buying warships. Chili has been very aggressive during the past quarter century, has made war upon each of her neighbors and wrested territory from them. Excepting Brazil, Argentina is about the only power in South America capable of offering resistance to the much-dreaded aggressor.

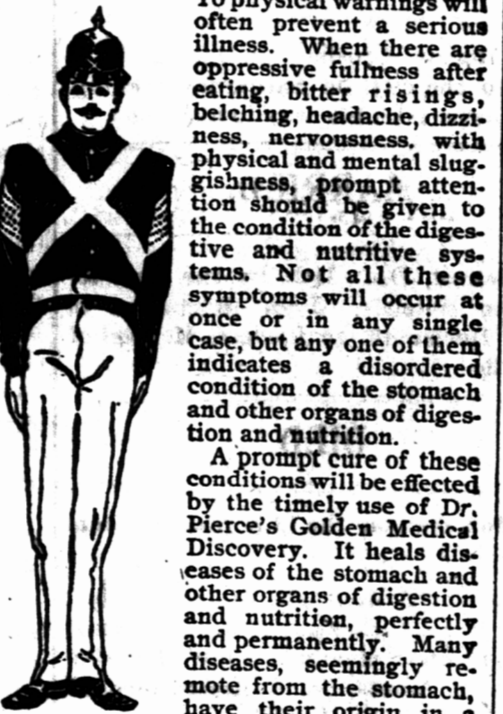
