THE AUTO ABROAD IN THE WORLD

It is but a few weeks since the first and self-moving carriage was introduced in Prince Edward Island. It is but a few years since the first of the present order of automobiles were put on sale in any part of the world for the use of the touring and pleasure-loving public.

France was even earlier in the field than Britain in the adoption of the new machine for road travel and has had many competitions over long and short distances in which world-records for the different types of steam, gasoline and electric automobiles have been established.

From France the automobile was introduced into the United States, and there in November 1901 at Ocean Parkway, Brooklyn the fastest mile record was made; time 51.45 seconds.

There are now from 10,000 to 12,000 automobiles in use in the United States, assuming an average cost of \$1,000 for each machine this means at the least an investment of ten millions of dollars.

with a capitalisation of \$32,344,000 have been formed to build auto-mobiles in addition to the companies before in existence which had a capital of \$25,000,000.
