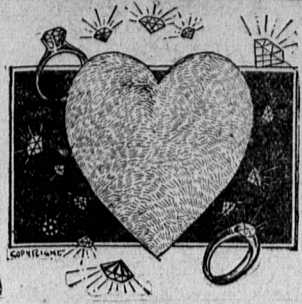

Summons have been issued in connection with the disturbance on Grafton Street late Saturday night referred to in yesterday's issue.

Rev J. F. Floyd preached a strong sermon Sunday night in the Central Christian Church on "Apostolic Succession and Christian Unity, or Do Protestant ministers have the authority to administer the Sacraments?" He took exception to some parts of Cannon Simpson's sermon printed in The Guardian on the 15th inst. in which it was contended that Protestant ministers can not properly administer the ordinances without being ordained at the hands of an Episcopal Bishop and that such ordination should be made a condition of unity with the Protestant denominations. The speaker contended that the modern Episcopal Bishop is unknown to the New Testament Scriptures. The qualifications of the apostles were such that they could have had no successors. The Bishops and Elders of the New Testament were the same officers, designated by the different names, and that there was a plurality of them in every local church. Paul left Titus in Crete that he might ordain elders, or bishops in every city; and Paul ordained elders in every city which he had established in Asia Minor. Hence the work and authority of these bishops was confined to the local congregations which had appointed them and to which they were amenable. It is a well-known historical fact that the modern Bishop is a development, instead of a divine appointment. First an undivided distinction was drawn between the deacons and the bishops. Then a distinction was made between the bishops and the elders. Still later one bishop was elevated above the other bishops. This bishop soon began to exercise authority over other local churches, forming a diocese. Metropolitans were appointed over the Bishops, and finally came the Roman pontiff. Hence the Episcopacy was evolved along the same lines as the papacy, only the Episcopacy stopped a little short of the Pope. In view of these facts it is evident that the ordination of the Episcopal Bishop is not necessary to empower the Protestant ministers to administer the sacraments; and by the same power that authorizes them to preach the gospel justifies them in baptizing their converts and giving them the Lord's Supper. It is hardly probable that the Bishop's hands had been laid on the head of the obscure disciple of Damascus who was sent by the Lord to preach to Saul of Tarsus and to baptize him. It is also clear, then, that Episcopal ordination should not be made a bar to Christian unity. Neither the Roman Catholics, on the one hand, nor the Protestant churches on the other, will ever consent to unite on such a basis. No human creed can ever be made the basis of union for the religious bodies of the world. They must all come to the Scriptures alone as their sufficient authority. They must all return to the simple and divinely appointed faith and practice of Jesus and his inspired apostles. They must accept the faith of the primitive churches in all its purity and their approved practice without change. They must all be satisfied to be Christians only.
