TEACHINGS OF THE LESSON.

1. God used to speak to many people in many places giving to each a little of divine truth, just so much as that person could understand and repeat. 4. Because of his sacrifice for us the whole universe through countless ages rises to do him honor. He is higher than all angels, a sceptre of righteousness is the sceptre of his kingdom, and forever he sits on the right hand of Majesty on high.
