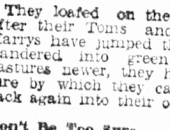

THE COOK'S CORNER

LAMB EN BROCCETTE (Serves 4 to 6). Three pounds lamb shoulder, 3 tablespoons olive oil, 6 tablespoons lemon juice, one onion minced, one teaspoon salt, bacon, cut in squares firm tomato.

Have the lamb shoulder boned and cut into 1-inch squares about 1-2 inch thick. Toss meat in marinade made of onion, olive oil and lemon juice. Let stand for several hours.

CURRIED LAMB AND NOODLES (Serves 4). Two tablespoons butter, 2 or 3 tablespoons curry powder, one tablespoon flour, 2 cups lamb stock or water, 1-2 teaspoon salt and a dash of pepper, one package of noodles, boiled and drained, 2-3 cups diced cooked lamb, 1-2 cup cooked peas.

LEMON BUTTER (An old English recipe). One pound granulated sugar, 3 lemons, 4 eggs, butter the size of an egg.
