ON CHURCH UNION.

(Continued From The Third Page).

One of the processes has perhaps not yet been reached. The cognate science of biblical theology proceeded *pari passu*, bringing out into clear definition the precise teachings of Scripture, their true character as the expression of religious faith and spiritual life, and not of theological speculation. The study of Scripture, as a gradual development of the revelation of God's will, led also to clearer discrimination of the form from the substance in Christian doctrine, and to the substance in Christian doctrine, and to greater emphasis of the New Testament statement as our final and perfect conception of revealed truth in Scripture. The result of this historical process, and especially of these studies, has been a broadening and liberalizing of our theology, and the relegation of questions of church polity very much to the region of Christian common-sense in the choice of means for the promotion of the work of God.

Another force has also been at work. The evangelistic and missionary spirit has, of late outstripped all other developments in the Christian church. This has brought what are known as the evangelical churches into co-operation and sympathetic touch, and has concentrated attention upon spiritual life rather than ecclesiastical form or speculative opinion. These forces have, within the remembrance of the writer, brought the churches named in your question very near to each other practically, so that in preaching, praying and Christian work, there is but little difference.

What, then, must be changed or removed. We answer, only those things which have already been so largely shaken *viz.*
1. The confusion of human speculative opinion with divine scriptural truth, and the disposition to exalt the former to the position of authoritative dogma.
2. The attempt to exalt traditional forms, even of apostolic origin, to such authority as to limit the freedom of the Spirit in the promotion of Christian work.
