EVIDENCE AGAINST THEM

Two C. P. R. Freight Trains Collide Head-on, Fireman Killed, Trains Wrecked.

FORAT TEMPTING MURDER.

ST. JOHN, Jan. 7.—(Special)—At the Police Court today the preliminary examination began of Fred King, Theodore Morrison, John Carlin and Samuel Stone on the charge of attempting to kill Frederick Globe by pushing him over the wharf on Saturday night.

INCRIMINATING TESTIMONY.

It was first thought that only an ordinary assault was intended, but a girl and boy who witnessed it say the men after pushing Globe over ran away and then came back smoking to ask what had happened.

ONE TRIED TO PREVENT.

The men are believed to have mistook Globe for Petersen who had hit Morrison. The evidence showed that Carlin tried to prevent a tragedy.

FREIGHT TRAINS COLLIDE.

SHERBROOKE, Jan. 7.—(Special)—Two freight trains on the Canadian Pacific collided head on near here during last night.

FIREMAN KILLED—ENGINEER HURT.

ROSS GOVERNMENT SUSTAINED IN THE ONTARIO BY-ELECTIONS

Three Seats Were Contested and All Probably Went Liberal, Two Having Been Conservative Before—North Norfolk is Close, North Grey Gives 250 and North Perth 200 Liberal Majority—Premier Ross Will Now Have A Working Majority.

PROBABLY THREE LIBERALS ELECTED.

TORONTO, Jan. 7, 10:30 p. m.—(Special)—Incomplete returns from the Ontario by-elections indicate the election of three Liberals, although the contest in Norfolk is close.

NORTH NORFOLK PROBABLY LIBERAL.

The latest figures give Little, Liberal a majority.

NORTH PERTH SURELY LIBERAL.

There is no doubt of the Liberal success in North Perth where Brown has about two hundred majority.

NORTH GREY SOLID FOR ROSS.

Nor is there doubt in North Grey where McKay's majority is about 250.

ROSS GOVERNMENT'S SAFE MAJORITY.

These victories will give the Ross Government a safe majority in the Legislature.

VETERANS IN CAUSE OF TEMPERANCE

Address Delivered by Hon. Peter McNutt, M. L. A.

ON 40TH ANNIVERSARY

Of Union Division S. O. T. of Summerfield Recently Celebrated. A Good Time Coming.

The following is the address delivered by Hon. Peter McNutt M. L. A. a charter member of Union Division S. O. T. on its fortieth anniversary recently celebrated at Summerfield, P. E. Island.

Ladies and Gentlemen,—I congratulate you upon the important and favorable circumstance under which we meet here to-night to commemorate the anniversary of Union Division, instituted in the year 1862, an event which well deserves to be kept in remembrance and duly celebrated.

The steady progress in the cause of temperance during the past forty years in disseminating temperance principle in the neighborhood, proves conclusively the wisdom of the movement in having the Division established, the blessed change that transpired in the locality in the face of existing difficulties, in closing down no less than four places where liquor was sold in violation of law, destroying the peace and morality of the neighborhood, with the sinful commotion and disturbance that always follows the accursed traffic.

We have reason to be thankful that Union Division had been organized and to the faithful band that are so persistently upholding it, to their faithfulness is greatly due the peace and sobriety that prevails among us now. True, like all other societies, temperance societies meet with disappointments and adversities, often from unfaithful members, in their own ranks violating their pledges and other causes, and falling in attempting to restore them to their former standing.

A great number of the clergy in all the churches are getting convinced that drunkenness is one of the greatest sins of the age, and from which many other heinous sins proceed, that would not be committed with people in their sober senses.
