THE NOVA SCOTIA LICENSE ACT.

With the Canada Temperance Act in force in the three counties of Prince Edward Island, in ten of the fourteen counties of New Brunswick and in twelve of the eighteen counties of Nova Scotia, both the two larger Provinces have liquor license acts for the regulation of the traffic in liquors within those sections where it is not otherwise delegatized.

The Nova Scotia Act, as pointed out by the Halifax Witness, provides for three kinds of licenses—hotel, shop and wholesale. The hotel license authorizes the licensee to furnish liquor to bona fide guests at table and in their own rooms that is the limit.

The holder of a shop license is entitled by its provisions to sell between certain specified hours and times, any quantity of liquor not exceeding two gallons, but not to be drunk on the premises.

Such then is the condition of the law with regard to the liquor traffic in Nova Scotia. In more than half its area the
