Moved by all these causes, the Ulsterman expressed their passionate desire for free trade and for a free Parliament. The occasion for the outburst was furnished by the American War of Independence. The emargoes laid upon export trade in 1776 intensified the misery of the people. The provision trade was seriously crippled; and the inhabitants of Wigan, Preston, Stockport, Manchester and other towns resented any counterbalancing advantages being given to the linen industry.

THINKS HIMSELF KING OF ENGLAND

HALIFAX, N. S., April 21.—"I am the King of the British Empire and I am worth a million pounds." Such was the declaration made by a well known man when arrested Monday evening for being incapable. When visited by his wife this morning he said "You are the Queen why should you worry." This is the state of mind of this unfortunate man who is an ex-soldier of the Imperial Army and a prominent musician in the 68th Regiment.

It is a sad case indeed. The man is the father of a large family and up to a few days ago was a sober hardworking man. He is an Englishman hailing from Lancashire. This morning in the police court his wife who was very much affected told the sad story to the magistrate. When asked if he wished to ask his wife, any questions, the unfortunate man went over close and whispered something to his wife who waved his hand out of court, but was restrained.

BROBE ORDERED INTO N. B. SCANDAL

FREDERICTON, N. B., April 20.—The charges made against Premier Fleming had their first and last Parliamentary hearing this afternoon in the New Brunswick Legislature when the Government decided that they should be probed by a Royal Commission to be appointed at once. The charges in question were made by L. A. Dugal of Madawaska County, and were to the effect, "that Premier Fleming and W. H. Berry, chief lumber scaler for the Province did extort large sums of money from the holders of timber licenses in this Province; and also that Premier Fleming and Hon. H. F. McLeod, formerly provincial secretary, but later representing York, N. B., in the House of Commons, received money from sub-contractors on the Valley Railway, the definite statement being made that \$10,000 was paid to the Premier and the sum of \$1,500 to Mr. McLeod.

NO CHARGE AGAINST DR. LANDRY.

There was quite a breeze when Mr. Dugan omitted the name of Hon. D. Landry, the present provincial Secretary, in succession to Mr. McLeod from the list of members of the Government whom he exonerated from all charges and suspicion. Dr. Landry demanded an explanation, saying he should either be exonerated or exonerated. Mr. Dugan hesitated, but when pressed said he had no charge or accusation to make against Dr. Landry, and his name was therefore added to the list of those exonerated.

To-night the House passed the bill authorizing a guarantee of bonds to the extent of \$10,000 per mile for the Valley Railway. The company constructing this road had under their charter authority to issue bonds to the extent of \$35,000 per mile and of this \$24,000 per mile had previously been guaranteed.

The purpose of the legislation is to bring the guarantee up to the total bond issue. An amendment to reduce the amount of the guarantee to \$7,500 per mile and to cancel the present contracts and make new ones was defeated.
