SUNDAY SCHOOL LESSON

LESSON IV. JANUARY 21: THE PRESENTATION IN THE TEMPLE

LUKE 2: 22-39. GOLDEN TEXT

"For mine eyes have seen thy salvation, which thou hast prepared before the face of all peoples."—Luke 2: 30-31.

POINTED SUGGESTIONS. by Rev. D. W. Snider. Blessed is the child of parents who are careful to obey both the laws of God and man, which sanctify his welfare from his birth.

Why should the parents of Jesus, unassailed by their poverty, be so prompt to bring the child to such a wondrous birth under the covenant of Abraham, and parents who claim to be followers of Jesus so frequently neglect to have their children baptized in His name?

How nearly will the prominent members of the church where you live measure up the character which is given to Simeon? How would the description which is applied to him fit your own case? Righteous and devout. Or would people understand better who was meant if that we left out and Mr. So-and-So, the sport, the politician, the lodge man, or the groucher, were put in?

Of course, Simeon was old and ought to be pious! It is good to find the old people, like Simeon and Anna, prayerful and spiritually expectant. So say we all. But how far back in their lives was it when the victor came to them of a Redeemer, for whom they waited? They were once younger, and we shall surely be old, and it is high time to come into close and loving and glorious antipatory fellowship with God.

Men sometimes cry out for death in the throes of agony and pain or in the deep distress of the protracted sickness which admits of no remedy but when Simeon asked to be unloosed from mortal bonds he gave a unique evidence of a relation to God that is precious. No earthly values can equal it.

Why did not Simeon push out another conditional "if" before saying his work was done and his course was finished and he was ready to depart? Men are continually saying that they will be content with God's will, though, if he death, if only they may see their families reared and provided for first, or have their debts paid, or see their children converted, etc., etc. But a new "if" is already at hand to be pushed out. Happier is he who fills his days with righteous and devout activities without stipulation and is ready for the will of God come life, come death. Blessed is he who is meet for his inheritance as a son of light.

Simeon and Anna had a clearer prophetic knowledge of what the service of the child Jesus should be among men than Joseph or Mary. And the forecast of godly neighbors as to the sphere of usefulness for which a child ought to be fitted, it is wisdom to ascertain.

Every decade of the Christian era has brought confirmation to the present words of Simeon. Has Jesus not been a light for revelation to the Gentiles? Has not Jesus brought crisis wherever He has been preached? And there is never crisis without clash and sword, without cleavage and division. The question is, Who is on the Lord's side?

Dear old Anna! The church ought to have wide room for those who haunt its courts to pray and talk religion. Perhaps if it had more room and welcome for such there would be more of them. And the Church would be richer for their sainthood.
