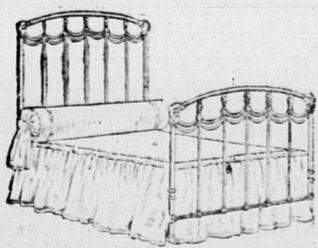

AIMS AND METHODS OF ENGLISH SUFFRAGETTES.

Much has been said and written of the belligerent tactics of the militant feminine band in England who are forcing the question of woman suffrage upon the public notice. Their action is deemed in all the moods and tempers, pronounced to be crazy and unwomanly. It is pointed out that if their cause is good these feminine would-be voters might hope to win by argument or persuasion but they can never hope to win by force.

In part this is beside the question. We presume the militant Suffragettes have no idea of conquering either the country or the Parliament by force. But they realize the benefit of advertising and the wonderful power of sympathy. They have certainly gained an amount of publicity by their methods which no mere platform or newspaper advocacy of their cause could have given them. However we may discredit their methods we must look at the results achieved.

They have set the United Kingdom, lands the growing temperance movement and the woman suffrage movement are very closely allied. There is very good reason to believe that going to jail, enduring prison fare if the women of Canada and the United States had equal rights with men at the polls, national prohibition would be speedily attained. TRAINED DOGS AS POLICE IN CITIES.

In various countries of Europe trained dogs have been brought into use to assist the police in the pursuit and capture of law-breakers as well as in preventing theft and burglary. Two years ago New York sent an officer over to Belgium where he studied the methods in vogue and obtained a few trained dogs for service. They have now been used for sixteen months with what is reported to be most satisfactory results.

Although but ten dogs were put to work they have brought about wonderfully improved conditions in the districts where they were employed.

It is said the bullseye target is deemed to go out of use in training rifle marksmen. Shooting at a plainly marked target and at a known distance is very unlike the actual conditions of war, where dusky figures in khaki are the objects and the distance has to be guessed. Some experts claim that shooting at a bullseye is rather a hindrance than a help in training for actual warfare. The Boers in South Africa were good shots, having been trained in hunting rather than in target shooting. There may be something worth considering in all this.

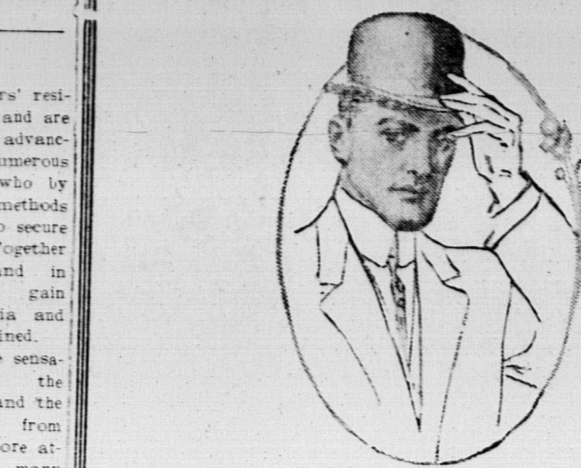

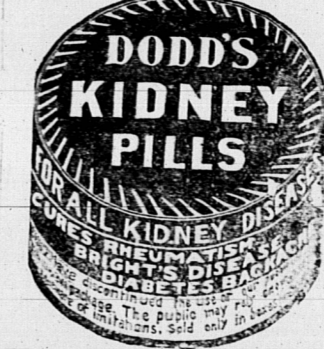
