This will be a general review of the transportation situation in the Maritimes, but will emphasise, chiefly, the fact that Prince Edward Island is the only Province in Canada that has been deprived of the Canadian Pacific Service, whereas this Province contributed to the establishment of the Canadian Pacific, as one of the early Partners of Canada.

The lecturer will be Mr. J. O. Hyndman, who has always taken a keen interest in our transportation problems.
