THE COOK'S CORNER

RAISIN SPICED COFFEE CAKE

- 2 cups sifted flour
- 3 tsp. baking powder
- 3-4 tsp. salt
- 1-3 cup sugar
- 1-4 tsp. cinnamon
- 1-4 tsp. nutmeg
- 1-3 cup shortening
- 1 egg, well beaten
- 1-2 cup milk
- 1-2 cup raisins, chopped
- 1 tsp. melted butter

Sift together 2 cups of the flour, baking powder, salt, sugar and spices. Cut in the shortening until the consistency of corn meal. Combine eggs and milk and stir into dry mixture. Add raisins with about 1 tsp. of flour. Spread evenly in a 9-inch greased layer cake pan. Brush with melted butter. Work 3 tsp. butter with a spoon until creamy. Then add 1-3 cup sugar, 3-4 tsp. cinnamon, and 3 tsp. nutmeg. Blend well. Sprinkle on top of coffee cake.
