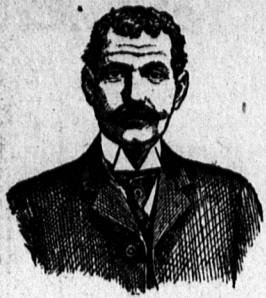

SOME MEMOIRS HON J.I. TARTE

History Of Retirement From Cabinet Cabal Against Him—Interesting Documents Found Among the Late Minister's Papers

MONTREAL, Feb. 8.—Some interesting documents are being found among the papers left by the late Hon. J. I. Tarte. The task of going through the six hundred pamphlets left by him is no small one, but it will throw many interesting sidelights on the political history of his day. The following extracts show his relations to his colleagues and to the premier prior to his resignation from the cabinet: "Prime minister away for several months. King's coronation. On his return reached Montreal Saturday, the 18th; duty and pleasure. Met and welcomed him. "Ottawa, the 19th, 5 o'clock, Sunday—Premier told me that some of my speeches had annoyed several of my colleagues, and were causing him trouble; that he regretted the course I had taken, etc. I assured him that

I had no desire to remain any longer a member of the administration; that, in fact, I had only waited his return to place my resignation in his hands. I reminded him that my speeches in his absence were not stronger nor more pronounced than those I had made to his knowledge and on several occasions during the last few years. I said, further, that I had reasons to believe that a cabal had been organized and conducted against me; that under the circumstances it was better for all concerned that he should accept my resignation immediately and without any discussion. I said: "You are a sick man I am in the best of health. Do not worry over the situation. Take my resignation with you. Appoint any body you like in my place. I will do no more in my power to spare you annoyance and trouble."

JUDGE WOULD INDICT BANKS

United States Judge Speaks Plain To Grand Jury On The Subject

NEW YORK, Feb. 8.—Judge Swan urged a thorough and rigid investigation of the recent bank failures in his address to the newly impaneled grand jury today. "The United States grand jury has already filed a number of indictments against wreckers of national banks," he said, "but I understand the special grand jury now investigating this class of crime has filed but one so far. If any member of this jury knows of any criminal acts in connection with bank failures it is his plain duty to call his associate's attention to that fact so that indictments may be found if the evidence warrants."

AMERICANS ARE UNSKILLED SHOTS

NEW YORK, Feb. 8.—There is no doubt but that a large proportion of our male population could be induced to take up rifle-shooting as a pastime if the opportunity were offered. That effective work could be secured by the training in rifle clubs has already been demonstrated. Canada's rifle clubs are a part of her military system, and in case of war would be turned into military companies.

In Switzerland every male citizen is trained in the use of the rifle. Three centuries old, here we are only just beginning. The way it can be accomplished here is for the Government to encourage, assist and maintain in a high degree of efficiency civilian rifle clubs. A comparison of civilian rifle club work in this country with that of other nations is a sad commentary of our neglected opportunities. The United States, with its eighty million or more of population for military service has only about eighty-five thousand men in all branches of the rifle club movement. The Government rifle clubs show about 1,800, and there are possibly 50,000 more who are familiar with rifle shooting of some sort. This leaves over fifteen million unorganized militiamen who are either ignorant or unskilled in the use of any kind of small arms.

TO MOVE FOR THE RELEASE OF H. K. THAW

NEW YORK, Feb. 6.—A decision as to what steps should be taken and when the first move should be made to secure the release of Harry K. Thaw from the asylum for the insane at Matteawan was expected to be reached today. It was announced that a conference between Thaw, his relatives and his counsel would be held sometime today at the asylum to decide whether or not to begin at once the proceedings toward his discharge from custody on the grounds that he is not now insane. There are three ways in which the attempt may be undertaken. One is to ask the superintendent of the Matteawan asylum to ascertain Thaw's sanity, another is to ask the state senate to appoint a commission to examine him, and the third is to produce him in supreme court by a writ of habeas corpus and have him examined by sheriff's jury. Synopsis of Canadian North-West HOMESTEAD REGULATIONS ANY even numbered section of Dominion Land in Manitoba, Saskatchewan and Alberta, excepting 8 and 26, not reserved may be homesteaded by any person who is the sole head of a family, or any male over 18 years of age, to the extent of one-quarter section 100 acres, more or less. Applications for entry must be made in person by the applicant at a Dominion Land Agency or Subagency for the district in which the land is situated. Entry by proxy may however, be made at an Agency on certain conditions by the father or mother, son, daughter, brother or sister of any intending homesteader. The homesteader is required to perform the homestead duties under one of the following plans. (1) At least six months residence upon and cultivation of the land in each year for three years. (2) A homesteader may, if so desired perform the required residence duties by living on farming land owned solely by him, not less than eighty (80) acres in extent, in the vicinity of his homestead, joint ownership in land will not meet this requirement. (3) If the father or mother, (if the father is deceased) of homesteader has permanent residence on farming land owned solely by him not less than eighty (80) acres in extent, in the vicinity of the homestead, or upon a home stead entered for by him in the vicinity such homesteader may perform his own residence duties by living with the father or mother. (4) The term "vicinity" in the two preceding paragraphs is defined as meaning not more than nine miles in a direct line, exclusive of the width of road allowance crossed in the measurement. (5) A homesteader intending to perform his residence duties in accordance with the above while living with parents and on a farming land owned by himself must notify the Agent for the district of such intention. (6) Six months' notice in writing should be given to the Commissioner of Dominion Lands at Ottawa, of intention to apply for patent. Deputy of the minister of the interior. N.
