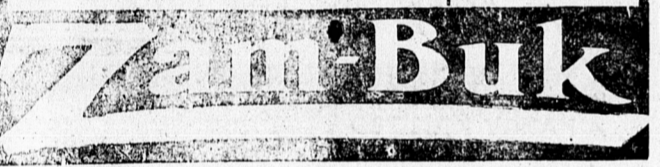

WINNIPEG, Dec. 2.—In the case of McLagan vs. John W. Dafor, the editor of the Free Press, on a charge of criminal libel, the jury returned a verdict of not guilty this afternoon.

FOSTER'S STATEMENT OF CLAIM IN LIBEL SUIT AGAINST GLOBE.

TORONTO, Dec. 2.—Hon. G. E. Foster's statement of claim in his libel suit against the Globe was filed today. The alleged slander was uttered at a public meeting held at Orillia, Oct. 20 last. Mr. Macdonald charged Foster with getting "an unjustifiable rake-off" in the notorious Swan River deal, and challenged him to serve him with a writ of slander.

WARM AND COLD IN BOSTON.

BOSTON, Dec. 2.—A warm wave, which swept down upon the city Monday night, gave way last evening before a cold blast from the west and within two hours the temperature had dropped 15 degrees, with conditions indicating freezing weather this morning. The mercury rose to 67, under the influence of a southwesterly breeze at the government bureau at one time yesterday, breaking all December records.

OTTAWA, Ont., Dec. 2.—The Supreme Court today began hearing the appeals of the Provinces of Ontario and Quebec against the Dominion in reference to the long standing disputes as to the adjustment of accounts of the old Provinces of Upper and Lower Canada in the matter of the interpretation of the "Northwest Angle Treaty" governing the disposal of 50,000 square miles of Indian lands around Lake of the Woods.

FORMER U. S. PRINCESS SINGS FOR A LIVING

PARIS, Dec. 2.—The Princess De Broglie who was a Mrs. S. B. Veit, of Chicago, has begun divorce proceedings against her husband on the grounds of desertion. She is singing in Paris restaurants to earn a living for herself and children and every night she makes a round of the better known cafes.

FOUR PEOPLE KILLED BY ENORMOUS CROWDS.

VIENNA, Dec. 2.—In honor of Emperor Francis Joseph's diamond jubilee, the city was illuminated last night on a scale of unprecedented brilliancy, the effect was enhanced by powerful search lights and Bengal lights playing from the high towers. The pressure of the enormous crowds in the streets caused several serious accidents. Four persons were killed and forty seriously injured, and more than a hundred others slightly hurt.
