Stock Markets At A Glance

WINNIPEG, May 18 - (CP) - Rye futures displayed firmness in trading today on the Winnipeg Grain Exchange during a session which saw offerings light and dealings slow. CHICAGO, May 18 - (AP) - Barley soared as much as four cents a bushel today and other grain futures were firm to strong with May corn frequently trading at \$1.18 1/2 the selling. MONTREAL, May 18 - (CP) - Papers were strong and active in trading that was otherwise along irregular levels on the Stock Exchange and Curb Market today. Papers mostly got inspiration for their uplift from the optimistic announcement of the United States war production board on Ontario newspaper prospects. TORONTO, May 18 - (CP) - The Toronto Stock Market featured the junior golds and Labrador in the Base Metals group today and while the gold group as a whole closed down moderately index gains were posted by the other groups. Labrador had a spurt in the final hour to set a new high price at 4 25. It closed at 4.30 for a net gain of 95 cents. Trade in Labrador totalled 26,700 shares. The Base Metal group had an index gain of 28, showing gains finally for Falconbridge, Hudson Bay and Wabigoon. Falconbridge advanced 65 cents and Hudson Bay added 1/2. Smelters and Nickel had minor losses.
