From the country to the city there is a constant and ever increasing stream flowing; this stream never ceases nor can it be checked or retarded.

Efforts have been made to slow up this stream, sermons have been delivered, editorials written against it, but the stream flows on, the producers on the farm are becoming the consumers in the city and the high cost of living increases.

Why does the country flow into the city? Ask the farmer. He has four sons and as many daughters. He sends them to school; they all receive a liberal education; in many cases the boys and girls, with usually the exception of a son, probably the eldest, who is needed on the farm, are sent to college; one becomes a lawyer, another a doctor, another a clergyman; the daughters become stenographers, nurses, book-keepers.

There are many exceptions to this rule; many farmers are able to provide farms for their sons, to purchase the farms of neighbors whose sons have gone to other professions and so the country is saved from actual depopulation. Yet in this highly favored province of ours there were, according to the latest census available, 174 unoccupied farms in Prince County, 168 in Queens and 188 in Kings County.

What is the remedy? Our farms, generally speaking, are becoming more prosperous; farming is becoming more attractive, more lucrative, less strenuous, yet the fact remains that the average farm can support only one of the sons; if the others are educated they take up other callings; if they have a bent towards mechanism or a commercial life they will follow their bent but the majority of the sons must leave the home nest and the only place available is the city where employment is to be found.

Why? A sort of impenetrable barrier has been placed at the junction of Prince and Kent Streets which citizens are somewhat puzzled over. It is a pile of gravel presumably placed there for storage purposes, certainly not for the improvement of the street.
