AMHERST FAIR.—At the Amherst Fair next week, there will be no lack of accommodation for guests. The entries exceed in every class those of last year, there being nearly 3000, representing all parts of New Brunswick, Nova Scotia and Prince Edward Island as follows:—Beef cattle, 138, dairy cattle, 103, sheep 204, swine 132, dressed beef carcasses 6, dressed sheep carcasses 18, dressed swine carcasses 70, live poultry classes, 9-8, live poultry, utility, 214, breeding pens 156, mating pens 70, collection of pigeons 80, turkeys 31, geese 56, ducks 77, sales pens 10, dressed poultry 250, exhibit eggs 16, fruit collection 39, honey 33, seeds 145. It will be seen by this list that there are large increases in the seeds, beet and dairy departments.

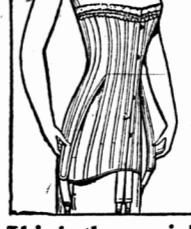
