GRAIN

CHICAGO, April 29 (AP)—The wheat market today duplicated its action of last Saturday and rallied sharply to close with fractional net gains despite receipt of good rains in the grain belt over the weekend, which caused an early slump in prices.

Wheat closed 1-4-3-4 higher, May 1.09 1-8-1.09, July 1.07 1-2-3-8; Oct 1-2-3-2, May 65 1-8-1-8, July 66-66 1-8; Oats 3-8 off to 1-8 up.

WINNIPEG, April 29 (CP)—Appreciable gains were scored by wheat futures prices on Winnipeg grain exchange today when the market followed Chicago's lead in rallying from early losses of a cent to a cent. Final quotations were 3-8-1-2 cent higher, May at 89 3-4, July 91 1-2 and Oct 93 1-2 cents.

Argentine wheat prices staged a mild advance at the opening but slipped back to unchanged levels as Buenos Aires trading progressed.

Livestock

MONTREAL, April 29 (CP)—The Quebec Department of Agriculture Marketing Service, reporting on livestock, said good cows sold early at \$5.75 to \$6. Other kinds of cattle were slow and generally estimated to be 25 cents or more lower. There were not enough sales to establish quotations.

Calves were 25 to 50 cents lower or quality considered. Good veal were mostly \$7 with odd tops at \$7.50, with medium kinds from \$6 to \$6.50. The bulk of the calves were of common to just plain quality and were sold in mixed lots between \$5 and \$5.50. Drinkers were \$4 to \$4.75.

Two spring lambs averaging around 70 pounds brought \$11 each and lighter kinds sold at \$8 to \$9 each. Common light spring lambs are not wanted. Last year's crop were from \$6 to \$8 per cwt. Sheep were from \$4 to \$6 with a few yearlings at \$5.50.

Hogs were moving very slowly. A few early sales were made at \$8.65 for bacon fat and watered. Selects drew \$1 per hog premium with the regular cuts on off grades. Sows were \$5 to \$5.50.

FINANCE

NEW YORK, April 29 (AP)—Specialists maintained a degree of popularity in today's stock market, but most leaders had difficulty in attracting buyers.

Shipping and machinery stocks were up in front throughout. Most finished under the best. Steels and motors, well up at one time emerged with only minor advances.

Rails, utilities, coppers, oils and rubbers got nowhere in particular. Canadian issues were easier. Dominion and Lake Shore, Imperial Oil, Imperial Tobacco, McIntyre and International Nickel dipped fractions. Distillers and Massey Harris were steady.

U. S. Steel was up 3-8 and Bethlehem 1-4. The Associated Press average of 60 issues was up 2 of a point at 50.2. Transfers of 566,950 shares were the smallest for a full session since March 18.

Favorites, some of them, included National Amun, Bridgeport Brass, White Sewing Machine, International Paper preferred, Pressed Steel Car, American-Hawaiian Steamship, N. Y. Shipbuilding, Westinghouse, Pan-American Airways, Grumman Aircraft, Boeing, Montgomery Ward, Sears Roebuck, Marshall Field and U. S. Gypsum.

TORONTO, April 29 (CP)—New index lows for the year were showing as the close of the stock market today for the industrial, the golds and base metal stocks and the western oils.

Senior oils dropped to new lows for the year and Imperial and International Petroleum were off 1-2 point. While British American recovered to show a small net gain. Bankers drifted downward and in the final prices were down for Dominion Foundries, National Steel Car, Page Hersey and United Steel.

Paper stocks closing higher included the Abitibi issues, Howard Smith and Consolidated Paper. Smelters, Pender Ores, Falconbridge, Sherritt and Waite Amulet posted moderate losses and soft spots in golds included O'Brien, Malartic, Macassa, Pamour and Wright Hargreaves. Steep Rock advanced 18 to 270.

Home Oil weakened 10 cents to 250 and Calgary-Edmonton and Okalta were slightly weaker.

AGE LIMIT ADVANCED

OTTAWA, April 29 (CP)—While the regulatory age limit has not been formally lifted, women up to 50 years of age may enter the competition for general examination for civil service commission stenographers, it was learned today. The age limit is 35.

Persons between the ages of 18 and 35 years are given preference. In permitting those between 35 and 50 years to apply the commission stipulated that they will be placed only when the lower age classification has been exhausted.
