Sir Henry Campbell-Bannerman's speech at Plymouth recently, the first meeting of his political tour of the West of England, is to hand to-day. It is the most vigorous piece of oratory the Liberal leader has produced for some time. A great part of it was devoted to ridiculing Lord Rosebery's "business men's cabinet." Who was to select that Cabinet? Inquired Sir Henry. The head of the State only acted by advice of his Ministers. Were the men to be co-opted by Ministers, or was there to be a committee of editors of magazines and newspapers to choose? Then where did the popular voice come in? That was a vital difficulty, which must cure anybody thoughtlessly bitten by the new idea.

The rest of the speech was largely devoted to self-defence against the charge of encouraging the Boers.
"I am afraid there is a good deal of the old Adam in the present Government. But here is the latest thing I have seen in the way of finding a scapegoat for their own iniquity: 'Dear Miss Milner.—We are much indebted to the Milner Habituation for their very kind and encouraging resolution, and I thank you heartily for the note in which you have forwarded it. We need such encouragement. (I can well believe it.) For England is, I believe, the only country in which, during a great war, eminent men write and speak publicly as if they belong to the enemy. Believe me, yours truly, Salisbury.' Well, I don't want to assume, before you or anyone else, the position of an eminent man; but I presume that I am one of those to whom Lord Salisbury refers. I am, at least a member of the Opposition, and have not failed or feared to speak out my mind. Now, I declare myself that, from first to last, I have never uttered one syllable that could be twisted by any ingenuity into encouragement of the Boers. No, I have never expressed ordinary pity for or sympathy with them, because I did not wish to run the risk of being misunderstood. What I have done, and what I hope I shall continue to do, is to denounce the stupidity of the way in which the Government were dealing with the Boers. This is the prime matter. Administrative errors of military blunders may cost lives and money and time, but their effect ceases with the end of the war. The political errors remain, and in their after results they may vitiate and frustrate all that the valor of our soldiers and the sacrifices of our people have won. But war, sooner or later comes to an end. What will be left after it? That is the question which the country is asking. Now, the cardinal point in the present case, and that which ought to have been never lost sight of from the first, but one which is much overlooked, and, as far as the Government are concerned, completely ignored, is this: hat men whose future disposition towards us were now forming, the men who will either be our friends or our foes in years to come, according as we treat them now, are the very men who will be our fellow-inhabitants permanently, and, as we hope, our fellow-subjects in South Africa. They are not—as we have sometimes been accustomed to see—they are not like some tribe of Pathans on the Indian frontier, or a herd of Dervishes in the Soudan,

A ROYAL BIRTH.
MADRID, Dec 3.—When the Princess of the Asturias, sister of the King, who was married February 14, 1901 to Prince Charles of Bourbon gave birth to a son Saturday, the Queen Regent the Infanta Isabella, and all the ministers were present at the palace.
The new born prince was placed upon a silver tray and handed to his father with great ceremony. Prince Charles carried the infant around and presented him to Premier Sagasta, the ministers and other dignitaries. The royal salute was fired. A telegram was sent to the Pope asking his blessing. It is expected the Pope will consent to be the young prince's godfather. He will be christened next Tuesday. His name will be Alfonso Andrew.
A royal decree has confirmed the order of the Golden Fleece and other decorations on the new born prince.
