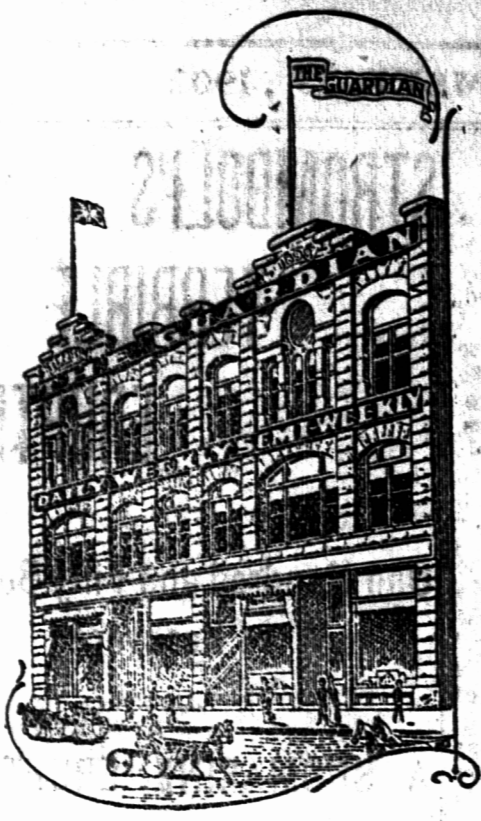

PREMIER BOND'S MISSION FAILS.

The Boston Herald says that Premier Bond's mission to Washington, has failed and he has returned home a disappointed man. This means much for Newfoundland and perhaps much also for Canada.

Canada checkmated the Bond-Blaine treaty of twelve years ago, but at the late Conference of Premiers in London, such pressure seems to have been brought to bear that either the Canadian objection to a renewal of negotiations was withdrawn, or was overruled by the Imperial Government.

But Mr. Bond has failed. According to the Boston Herald he met with "an exceedingly chilly reception" at Washington. The party in power at the American Capital are warmly in favor of reciprocity in the abstract.

The Yorkshire Daily Observer is quoted in reference to a cheap class of covers brought out by some leading manufacturers, composed of a mixture of worsted warp, and a cheap carded web termed Angola, a high sounding name for a blend of cotton with mungo.
