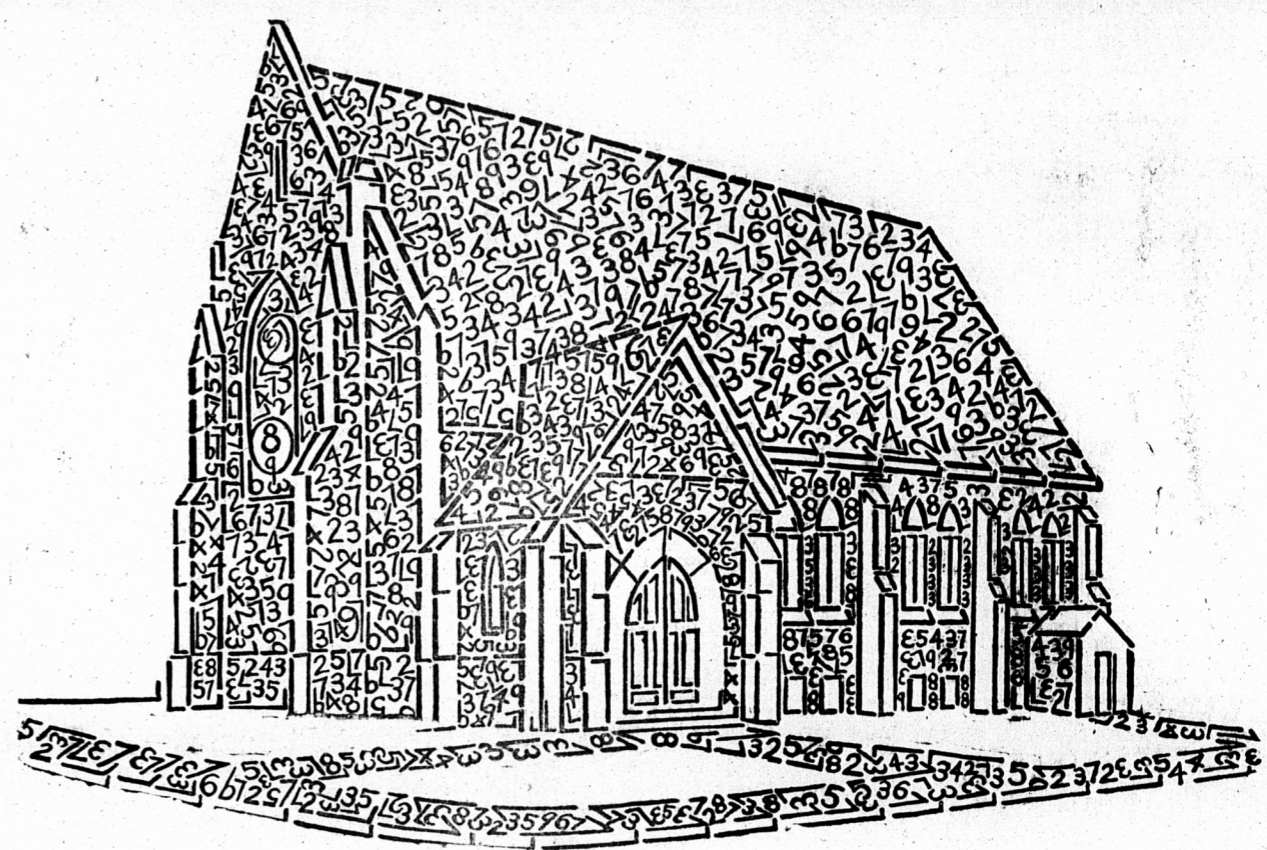
Approved Methods In Land Cultivation

(Experimental Farm note) The question of the responsibility of the grass pea (Lathyrus sativus L.) for poisoning of man and animals has been referred to the Division of Botany for preparation of a statement to be placed before the public.

Seed houses show occasional interest in it, but with probably no great response from the public.

of species of the Lathyrus, including sativus, have been examined for alkaloids and none have been found. There is, however, an extensive literature on a disease known as lathyrism which is particularly prevalent where large quantities of Lathyrus sativus have been consumed.
