

**REFUSES TO AID LIQUOR DEALERS**

Tells Deputations He Will Not Interfere With Toronto Council.

TORONTO, Feb. 23—Premier Whitney received a deputation of liquor men today, who asked him to pass legislation to prevent a reduction in licenses as resolved on by the Toronto city council going into effect.

It would be distinctly improper to interfere with the plain, emphatic answer to Premier Whitney. He told the deputation that the council acted within their jurisdiction. That being the case, remedy must be sought from the people who elected the council, not from any higher authority. For the government to interfere would bring about disorder and pandemonium.

**ALONE FOR SEVEN DAYS WITH CORPSE IN A LIGHTHOUSE**

TOLEDO, Ohio, Feb. 23—Making his way over long stretches of treacherous ice from the Toledo harbor lighthouse, where for seven days he had been imprisoned with the dead body of Capt. Delos Hayden, Joseph reached this city yesterday afternoon.

He brought the news of the death to friends and relatives, telling of the nerve racking vigil beside the dying man in the lighthouse, and his still more trying experience while watching over the dead body, waiting for a turn in the weather which would permit his escape over the ice.

Courting death in a hazardous trip of ten miles across the ice-laden bay in order that an invalid wife might look upon the face of her dead husband, a relief expedition of five men started for the Toledo harbor lighthouse to bring in the dead body of Capt. Hayden.
