

Last year, they wrested the palm from the University of New Brunswick; this year they added another laurel to their debating honors by receiving a two to one vote of the judges over the Dalhousie Co-ed debating team. The debate was held in the Assembly Hall of the School for the Blind. The subject, of which Mount Allison held the affirmative side, was: "Resolved, that, with the exception of those already under private operation, the natural resources of Canada in oil, gas, water power and mine should be publicly owned and operated." Dalhousie was represented by Miss Florence MacKinnon (leader), Miss Eva Marder, and Miss Clara Murray. The judges were, Rev. Professor Shaw of the Pine Hill College, Principal Cummings of the College of Agriculture, Truro, and A. F. MacDonald, of Halifax. When these officials had assumed their several stations the resolution was read by Miss Blackwood, principal of the Halifax Ladies' College, who occupied the chair.
