A THIRTY THOUSAND

Dollar Subsidy for P. E. Island.

PAID TO US YEARLY On Account of Failure to Give Daily Winter Steam Service.

OTTAWA, May 4.—Hon. W. S. Fielding Finance Minister, has given notice of the following resolution:—That after the 1st day of July, 1901, shall be paid to the Province of Prince Edward Island, in addition to all sums now authorized by law, an annual allowance of \$30,000, which allowance shall become payable and be paid to the Province half yearly, on the first day of July and January of each year, beginning with the first day of July next.

Such allowance to be paid and accepted in full settlement of all claims of the Province against the Dominion on account of the non-fulfilment of the terms of union between the Dominion and the Province as respects the maintenance of efficient steam communication between the Island and the mainland.

VERY WIDE AND LONG

Ten Thousand Homeless—15 Millions of Property and Seven Lives Lost.

TWO MILES OF DESOLATION.

JACKSONVILLE, May 4.—(Special.)—The great fire here destroyed 148 blocks and seven persons lost their lives.

A big special military and police force is being mustered to prevent lawlessness. The path of the flames was 13 blocks wide and nearly two miles long.

TEN THOUSAND HOMELESS.

The number of homeless reckoned on are 10,000 and the property loss about fifteen millions.

BEGINS TO-DAY.

The Examination of Archibald McLeod.

AT CITY COURT ROOM.

The Accused Sleeps Well—Course the Proceedings will Take Place.

The preliminary examination of Archibald McLeod, charged with murdering his mother, Isabella McLeod on the 9th of April last, will commence before Stipendiary Magistrate Palmer in the Police Court room at eleven o'clock this morning.

We learn that the prisoner slept soundly on Friday night. This, however, might be owing to the fact that he had no sleep on Thursday night.

McLeod's appearance would in no way indicate that he would be guilty of the crime he is charged with. He stands about six feet in height, and weighs about 180 lbs. has a florid complexion, a red face and light mustache.

We understand that it is not the intention of the prisoner's counsel to offer any evidence at the preliminary investigation, but will reserve his defence for the Supreme Court in case the prisoner is committed for trial and therefore the witnesses for the Crown will not even be cross examined.
