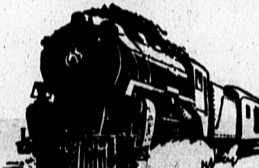

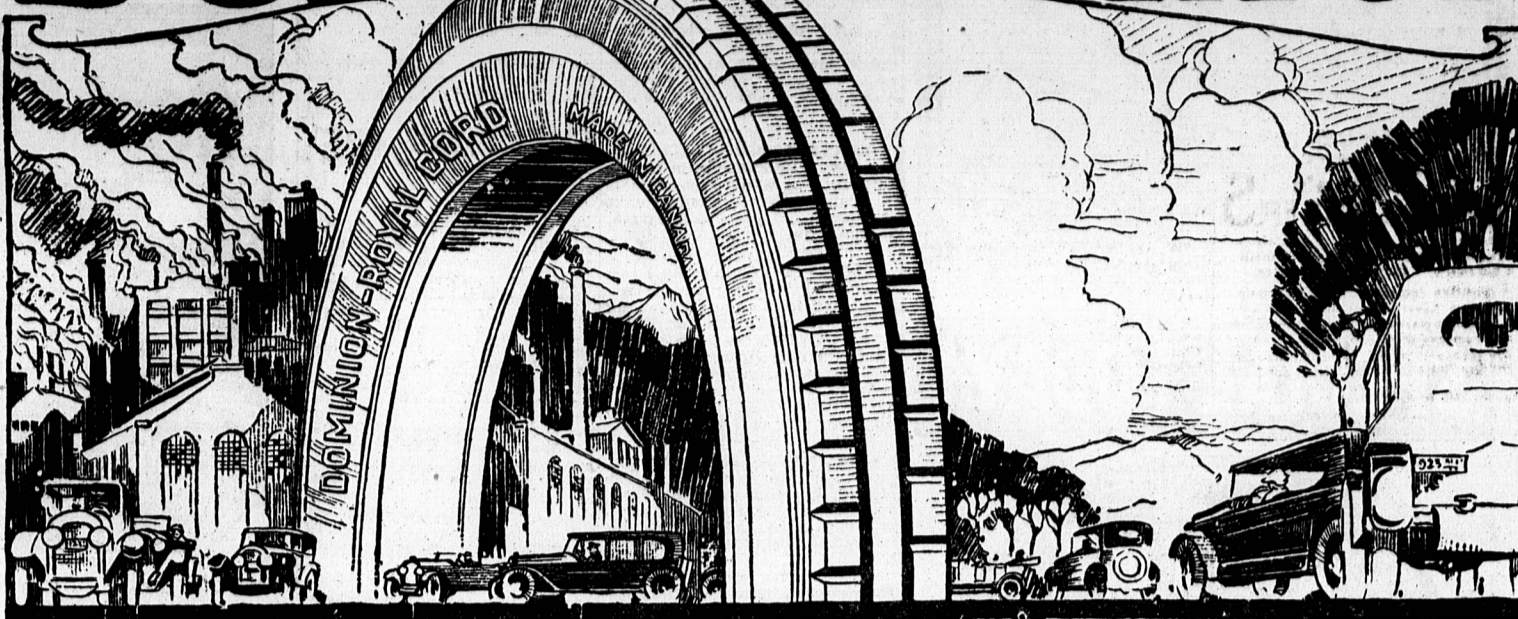
Montmartre Has Enlarged Dignity
