MORGAN OFFERED \$400,000.

LONDON, February 22.—The Daily Express prints a despatch from The Hague, saying that Dr. Bredius, curator of the celebrated Mauritshuis gallery at The Hague, received an offer from Mr. J. Pierpont Morgan of \$400,000 for Rembrandt's painting of "Sul and David," which Dr. Bredius bought for the gallery for \$40,000. Dr. Bredius refused the offer, on the ground that he did not wish the picture to leave Holland.
