## THE VALUE OF HAVING THE HOME MOTOR IN USE

This estimate is taking into account pleasure boats only—of working and fishing craft there will also be quite a few added.

Those residents of Charlottetown who contemplate changes in and from their former boats are quite a number. The desire for speed is evident in most of their cases, and each is working out his problem in his own way. Their greatest question is as to what kind of engine to install and the result of their endeavors will be full of interest for those who are bitten with the "bug" and do not yet know what to get in the way of boat or motor.

For all general purposes Charlottetown is fortunate in having here an engine locally made which is all that can be desired. 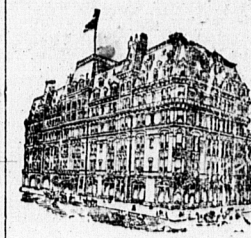

## SUNDAY SCHOOL LESSON

SECOND QUARTER. APRIL 7.

LESSON 1. THE APPEARANCE OF THE RISEN LORD. (Easter Lesson) (Cor. 15: 1-11). GOLDEN TEXT.

"This Jesus did God raise up, whereof we all are witnesses."—Acts 2: 32.

POINTED SUGGESTIONS.

It is scarcely possible to overestimate the value of the fact, with all its glorious implications, of the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead.

Study that evidence by asking, Who provides it? What is his character? When did he furnish his evidence? Under what circumstances? With what purpose? Can it be shown that Paul is not the author of the letter to the Corinthians? What is the date of the writing? How long after the facts occurred of which the Apostle makes so much is that date? Was his statement of the facts ever successfully challenged?

God does not leave Himself without witness and He put into good hands the necessary for the earliest written historical proof of our Lord's resurrection. That necessity arose out of an intellectual error which those who were morally sound were in danger of falling into. But that error would have undermined and destroyed that soundness. The Apostle leans to their rescue with the urgency of his great fundamental doctrine as the basis of Christian belief and character, and makes his whole statement of the resurrection, the facts, the proofs, the argument, the illustrations, the inferences, live and flame and ring with truth.

The Apostle Paul stakes every whit of the fact and power and value of Christianity upon the truth of the resurrection of Jesus. Christianity, which brings salvation, is worse than a minus quantity if there is no resurrection from the dead. It is falsehood, and men may as well build hopes on bottomless misery.

But the gospel which Paul preached, he would have the Church at Corinth understand, has a thoroughly-attested historic basis—strong enough and effective enough to carry the world's need, unless men believe in vain. That is their own lookout. The fact that the limping faith of a man says that the bridge will not carry him will not crack a single timber nor loosen a single rivet.

What are the facts of the resurrection? First, a death; secondly, a burial; thirdly, an empty grave and the appearance, alive, of the One who was dead and buried. But note the significant words, "according to the scriptures." Would Paul's reference to the Scriptures add to or take from the necessity that he should be sure of his facts and of the mighty doctrines he built upon them?

Who certifies to the facts? How did they come into the possession of them? Had they anything to gain by any other relation of them than the true relation? What influence had the facts of which they gave witness upon themselves? If they had been mistaken, what then? Remember, twenty-five years have passed, and many bands of believers are scattered abroad.

Paul was not an eye-witness in the sense that Cephas was or the Twelve; but the Apostle claims that he, too, can testify to the appearance of the resurrected Jesus. How? Must not others have a similar revelation? Grace is the compensation. Grace can rebuild character. Grace can

resurrect a soul. Grace can give clearer vision to the understanding of faith than sight to the eyes of unbelief.

If Christ is risen He is a living Christ. If we are followers of His, it is because we are dead, indeed, unto sin but alive unto God, having been raised from the death of sin unto the life of righteousness.

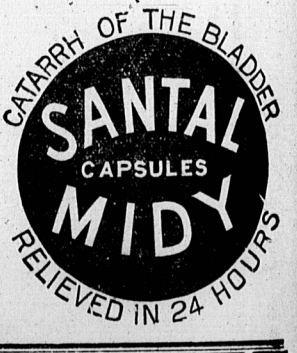
## Results of Father Burke's Test

Rev. Father Burke of Alberton conducted an experiment on hay some time ago and his success is just an idea of what other men can do. In Father Burke's test one plot was left unfertilized and yielded 2040 lbs to the acre.

Plot No. 2 was fertilized with muriate of potash, acid phosphate and sulphate of soda and yielded 6120 lbs. per acre. At the present price of hay, \$12 a ton, plot No. 2 yielded Father Burke \$24.48 more than plot No. 1 and deducting the cost of fertilizer \$11.04, his net gain was \$13.44.
