REJOICING IN OUR DIFFERENCES.

God plainly intends us all to be different from each other. It may reasonably be believed that God never produced two works of creation of identically the same sort. This seems to be true of living things and inanimate things: planets, stars, worlds, crystals, flowers, fishes, birds, animals, men. So there is no reason for us to chafe or rebel when we find that there are in ourselves deep-seated differences from others, or when we find in others deep-seated differences from that which we think we should have designed had we been in charge. He set his face steadily against it and these men went so far as to threaten him with dismissal. Under these circumstances I would like to know whether Mr. Hegan would have the power to resist that kind of thing in the future as he has done in the past, or whether it is because of his resistance that his responsibility will be taken away from him.

Mr. Hegan himself or is it second-hand?

Mr. HUGHES: That is hardly a fair question; it is well known it was done. And although I do not think anything of the kind was done by the members supporting the Government in this House, and perhaps they would not approve of it, yet I think they knew it. I am not surprised that Mr. Hegan has asked for a change, because it was a difficult position for him to occupy. He had to put up a fight for the protection of the department, that must have been very unpleasant for him. I tell the minister that it is my opinion that if Mr. Hegan's power is taken away from him the department will suffer. So far as his politics are concerned, I heard him express himself in words that would indicate that he had Conservative leanings, but I do not think he has any party beyond the fact that he was appointed by Sir John Macdonald. The department would be well advised to strengthen Mr. Hegan's hand rather than take power from him. Mr. Hyndman is a good man, I think, but he knows what is going on and if he knows that his chief was kicked upstairs for trying to protect the department it is only natural to expect that Mr. Hyndman will not seek to borrow trouble by doing the same thing. The chief engineer was supposed to have charge of the dredging of the province, but since the Government came into power a superintendent of dredging was appointed and I do not know whether Mr. Hegan was over the superintendent or the superintendent was over the engineer, but I do know that a new captain was appointed on dredge No. 9, and the captain was doing private dredging for Matthew and McLean at Souris, and against the wish of Mr. Hegan, and Mr. McLean of the firm of Matthew and McLean told Mr. Hegan he would not allow him to interfere. He called the captain to account for doing work without the authority of the officers of the department, and the captain of the dredge went on and did the work. I put a question on the Order Paper this session asking what dredging has been done for private firms, or parties in Prince Edward Island, and the answer was none, except half a day's dredging done for McDonald Brothers, Georgetown, and the department did not think it worth while to charge for that. I say that the department did private dredging for McLean at Souris and the captain knows it.

Mr. McLEAN: Does Mr. Hegan know it?

Mr. HUGHES: Yes, he had a dispute about it, for Mr. Hegan objected to the captain doing it without authority from him or from the department, I understand that Mr. Poole of Lower Montague wanted dredging done, but the department would not do it unless it was paid for. I think everybody should be rested in the same way. These are the facts and I would ask the ministry to have an enquiry made.

Mr. ROGERS: We will look into it and if the statement the hon. member makes is in accordance with the facts, we will fire everybody connected with it.

Some hon. MEMBERS: Hear, hear.

Mr. McLEAN: The hon. member (Mr. Hughes) made the statement that Mr. Hegan was approached by leading conservatives and asked about a rake-off on public works.
