NEW LINE OF ACTION IN THE A. J. SMALL CASE

TORONTO, March 28.—The Provincial Attorney General's Department has commenced an entirely new line of action in regard to the Ambrose J. Small disappearance.

Richard H. Greer, K. C., former County Crown Attorney, one of the city's most prominent lawyers and criminal prosecutors, has been requested, it is understood, to communicate with Gideon Grant, K. C., in regard to further investigation of the mystery.

Mr. Greer was appointed as special crown prosecutor in the trial of John Doughty, former secretary of the missing man, who is now serving a six year term in Kingston Penitentiary and his work at that time was considered thoroughly satisfactory by the Attorney General and other interested parties.
