2 Kings 11: 8, 20.  
GOLDEN TEXT.  
"Blessed are they that keep His testimonies and that seek Him with the whole heart."—Ps. 119:2.

POINTED SUGGESTIONS.  
By Rev. D. W. Snider.

As there are portions of the territory through which the railways pass in crossing a continent that afford no pleasure to the traveller—lonely, rocky, barren, uninviting stretches—so that upon a second journey he fully shuts out the scene, likewise in the records of faithful history there are passages which besides being uninviting, except to those who can sympathize with the heroes, are also revolting to consideration. The chapters between and the last contain such a record.

But as the continuity and value of one's journey upon the track which takes the traveller over the uninviting territory, so through the dark and blood-stained places of history there run, like bands of gleaming steel, the purposes of God. Amid the recital of all dynastic upheavals, and misalliances, and wickedness, and slaughter, fix upon and study out this oft-repeated statement: "For David, my servant's sake."

The lesson presents a good example of the blessings which come to mankind through the sacrificial initiative of the God-fearing and of the value of a thoroughly organized purpose when the time is ripe. Those who secreted the young prince, Joash, from the cruel talons of his grandmother, Athaliah, risked their own lives, and the capacity of Jehoida, the priest, for generalship is worthy of all praise.

The dramatic and tragic attitude may be quite striking and impressive, but it is of little worth when the game is up. Usurpers and hypocrites are often master hands at the show of dignity, and they may even have the blood-quality of it in their veins, as Athaliah, but though is misled the people of the time, "it cannot fool the people all the time."

It is scarcely true that a man's word is as good as his bond. The word of some men may be a great deal better than the bond of other men, but the bond of each will carry him somewhat further than his word. Herein is the value of covenants. It is significant that so many famous historical events have been carried through under covenant.

"Be not unequally yoked together with unbelievers." The troubles of the misalliances are many and terrible. One of the first things to consider is the problem of matrimony is that of harmonious religious convictions and affiliations. Where that is wanting the devil of cruelty may leap from the breast of a grandmother.

What security is there in the methods and instruments of evil? When can one suppose that the round of them is complete? Athaliah thought she had managed her case well, nevertheless Joash was secreted in the lumber room of the temple. The embezzler, the thief, the murderer, the evil-doer, no matter what his class of crime, the sinner, no matter what the nature of his sin—they are never secure.

Justice, eternal justice, is continually sifting and sifting the purposes, and plans, and needs of men. There is nothing secret that shall not be revealed. "No wrong can go down secure and compact through the ages."

**THE TOWER OF BABEL.**

The German excavators of ancient Babylon believe that they have identified the remains of the Tower of Babel, although there appears to be some doubt as to which of three structures constitutes the foundation of the real Babel. Further excavations are to be made, and are expected to settle the question. The ruins of Nebuchadnezzar's palace, where Belshazzar's feast took place, and where Alexander the Great died, have been shown to cover the remains of quay walls built on the riverside by Sargon and Nabopolassar. The enormous brick buildings constructed by the Babylonian architects were veneered with glazed and colored bricks in ornamental designs.

Mrs. Agnes L. Riddle, the republican woman representative took the chair when the house resolved itself into a committee of the whole yesterday afternoon and presided during an afternoon of hot debate. That Mrs. Riddle made one of the best presiding officers that have been in the chair in the present session was the opinion of the members of the house, and she was warmly applauded when she surrendered her position at the close of the committee meeting. Several members during the course of the exciting debate on the child labor bill appealed loudly to "Mr. President," only to correct themselves by asking for "Mrs. President." Some insisted on "Mrs. Chairwoman," while a few used what has come to be considered the correct term, "Madame Chairman."—Denver Republican.


